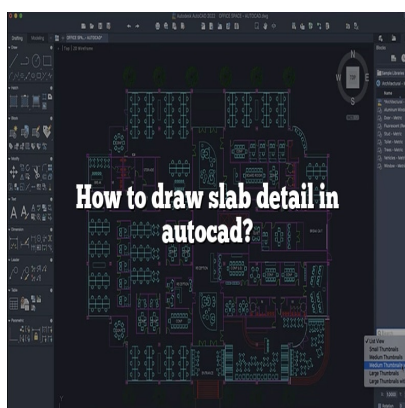




How to draw slab detail in autocad?

1. Open the Design tool palette, and select the Slab tool or the Roof Slab tool.
2. On the Properties palette, click the Design tab, expand Basic, and expand General.
3. Under Style, select a slab or roof slab style.
4. Specify a value for Bound Spaces:

1. Click Layout tab > Create View panel > Detail drop-down > Circular.
2. Click the view to use as the parent view.
3. Click in the drawing area to define the center of the area to magnify.
4. Click to specify the diameter of the area to magnify.

How do you create a slab reinforcement?

The maximum diameter of bar used in slab should not exceed $1/8$ of the total thickness of slab. Maximum spacing of main bar is restricted to 3 times effective depth or 300 mm whichever is less. For distribution bars the maximum spacing is specified as 5 times the effective depth or 450 mm whichever is less.

How do I make a RCC roof slab?

1. Effective depth $d = \text{Span} / ((L/d)_{\text{Basic}} \times \text{modification factor})$
2. For obtaining modification factor, the percentage of steel for slab can be assumed from 0.2 to 0.5%.
3. The effective depth d of two way slabs can also be assumed using cl.

What is one-way slab in civil engineering?

The one-way slab is a slab, which is supported by parallel walls or beams, and whose length to breadth ratio is equal to or greater than two and it bends in only one direction (spanning direction) while it is transferring the loads to the two supporting walls or beams, because of its geometry.

How can we find one-way slab and two way slab?

If the ratio of long side / short side > 2 it is considered as one-way slab, and if longer side to shorter side ratio

What is a slab in construction?

slab, In architecture, a flat, monolithic piece of stone or concrete used for a floor or roof.

The concrete slab is generally positioned on a layer of sand in order to improve drainage conditions and to act as a cushion. A concrete slab does not have a crawlspace underneath it. This type of foundation differs from house foundations with basements in this respect: There is no space under the floor.

Introduction. A slab is a structural element, made of concrete, that is used to create flat horizontal surfaces such as floors, roof decks, and ceilings. A slab is generally several inches thick and supported by beams, columns, walls, or the ground.

What is beam details?

A beam is a structural element that primarily resists loads applied laterally to the beam's axis (an element designed to carry primarily axial load would be a strut or column). Its mode of deflection is primarily by bending. The loads applied to the beam result in reaction forces at the beam's support points.
