Is Cinema 4D free with Adobe?

Adobe After Effects includes a free installation of Cinema 4D Lite – a limited but feature rich version of Maxon's award-winning 3D software package. Cinema 4D Lite can be accessed directly from within After Effects in the File > New menu, or by clicking Edit Footage on a Cinema 4D layer in your composition.

How do I export from DCI?

dci item on the sheet or in the Item Tree. Go to File > Export > Render Variations of Selected Asset in Modo. A Render Stored Variations in Modo dialog appears.

What format are movies exported?

You can export a movie to save a copy of it with a specific resolution or file format. Your movie is exported as a QuickTime movie (. mov) using the H. 264 or HEVC codec.

How do I export from After Effects to Cinema 4D?

1. Choose File > Import > File.
2. Select the CINEMA 4D file and click Import. The file is placed in the Project panel as a footage item. You can place the footage item on an existing composition, or create a matching composition.
