Also, how do you edit shapes in **TinkerCAD**?

As many you asked, how do you **fill** letters in TinkerCAD? For instance, TinkerCAD has the ability to add text to your workspace. This might be useful if you want to carve your name into an object, extrude text for a label, etc. To make text, select the 'Text' **shape** under the basic shapes tab. This will add a shape into the workspace that just says 'text' for now.

Correspondingly, how do you make a hollow object solid in **TinkerCAD**?

Also know, how do you color in TinkerCAD? To change the color, select the **shape** you are wanting to change by clicking on it. Once you have selected the shape, press the 'Solid' button from the shapes inspector located on the upper right corner panel (marked by a blue square). The color panel will appear showing a selection of colors that you can choose from. To start sign in to your Tinkercad account and find the model you want to sculpt. Click on the model and press the download button on the right. Next click . stl and it will start downloading automatically.

Drag the Text shape from right panel and enter your text. Rotate the Text to make it perpendicular to the S-Wall shape. Hold down the Shift-key while you rotate to make this more accurate. Stretch the depth of the Text (or raise the height in the inspector).

In Tinkercad, select all the parts of your object and click the Group button, then click on the grouped object, press the Solid color button, and check the Multicolor box.

The "Multicolor" option can be found under the color panel in the shape inspector. This option preserves the original colors of the shapes in your design when grouping.

Click on the height node (gray box in the middle of the top of your box object). This will display the height (in inches) of your box. Click on the dimension (1 in this case) and change it to 0.1. In my experience, 0.1 inches is a good thickness for walls for an enclosure like this.
