## How do I size a keyframe in Cinema 4D?

1. STEP 1: SELECT THE OBJECT YOU WANT TO KEYFRAME IN THE OBJECT MANAGER.
2. STEP 2: GO TO THE FRAME IN THE TIMELINE RULER WHERE YOU WANT TO INSERT THE KEYFRAME.
3. STEP 3: PUSH THE SET KEY BUTTON IN THE ANIMATION PALETTE.
4. STEP 4: RINSE AND REPEAT.

## Where is reset PSR?

Reset PSR Button to Your Layout Then select customize palette, a customize command and the palette will appear. Use the Name Filter search area to look for PSR or Reset. You will notice Reset PSR on the list. Now you need to drag Reset PSR to the layout of the point where you like to keep it.

## What is the axis of an object?

An axis is an invisible line around which an object rotates, or spins. The points where an axis intersects with an object's surface are the object's North and South Poles.

You can change the Anchor Point by using the Anchor Point drop down to select preset locations such as Model Center, From Model, Top Bottom, Front, Back, Left, Right. You can also use the Anchor Offset to move it to a custom location. Create a Group Null and move the Anchor Point with the pan behind tool to offset it.

## How do you keyframe?

1. Click the Stopwatch icon next to the property name to activate it. After Effects creates a keyframe at the current time for that property value.
2. Choose Animation > Add [x] Keyframe, where [x] is the name of the property you are animating.
