While in a part or part template, left click the "View" tab then find the "User Interface" icon and select the drop down list. There you will either see "Model" or "Model Browser" depending on the version you are using. This solved it.

The model tree can also be customized to display other information.

Additionally, how do I **get** my ribbon back in **Inventor**? To restore the full ribbon, right-click the tab bar and select Ribbon Appearance Reset Ribbon.

Where is the standard toolbar in Inventor?

Main window. By default, the Standard toolbar is at the top and the browser is on the left. A window-specific context menu is accessible through a right-click for all environments.

How do I change the toolbar in Inventor?

On Quick Access toolbar, click the drop-down arrow. On the Customize menu, click the command name you want to display on the QAT.

How do I enable browser in Inventor?

Click the View tab. Click the User Interface command and check a box to turn on an interface component or uncheck it to turn it off.

What is the browser in Autodesk Inventor?

When the Autodesk Inventor link is installed, it adds a BlueCielo browser to the Autodesk Inventor browser panel.

How do I create a detail view in Inventor?

Create a Detail View On the ribbon, click Place Views tab Create panel Detail . Click to select an existing view as the parent view. In the Detail View dialog, set the view identifier, scale, and visibility of the view label. If needed, click Edit View Label and edit the detail view label in the Format Text dialog.

How do you make a 3d tree in AutoCAD?

1. Draw two polylines, Draw Polyline or , to describe the profile of your tree, one for the canopy and one for the trunk. Make sure that you join the two polylines end to end, use the Endpoint Osnap,
2. You have now drawn all of the constructional elements you need.

How do you plant trees in AutoCAD?

1. Open the Insert dialog box and click on the Browse button.
2. Browse through the collection until you find the block of trees or plants that you want to insert.
3. Use the dialog box settings in the same way you would for a block within your drawing.
4. The last step is very important.

How do you make a 3d plant in AutoCAD?

How do I get my vault tab back in Inventor?

1. Open Inventor.
2. Tools tab.
3. Add-Ins.
4. Display hidden Add-ins (right click in dialog box).
5. Select "Inventor Vault" and "EDM Addin."
6. Enable "Loaded/Unloaded" and "Load Automatically" for these Add-ins.
7. Click OK.

What is ribbon in Inventor?

When you open the application, the ribbon displays automatically across the top of the main window, providing access to a palette of commands and controls. The ribbon is organized into tabs, labeled by task. On each tab, commands are displayed on a series of panels.

How do I expand my tool bar in Inventor?

Where is the Quick Access toolbar in Inventor?

The Quick Access Toolbar is the row of commands on the top of the Inventor Window. You can add or remove commands from the QAT (Quick Access Toolbar) by clicking the down arrow on the right side of the toolbar.

How do you share a sketch in an Inventor part file?

1. Click the sketch or feature to share.
2. Right-click the sketch or feature icon and choose Share Sketch (for sketches) or Share (for surface or work features) in the context menu.
3. Click the feature or sketch and drag it above its parent feature.

How do you customize inventor?

1. On the ribbon, right-click, and select Customize User Commands.
2. In the Customize dialog box, select one or more commands, and then click Add.
3. Click OK to add the selection to the User Commands panel.
