Introduction

- 1. On the Ribbon, go to Home tab > Expand Annotation drop-down > Dimension styles manager.
- 2. Select the Dimension style to change and click Modify.
- 3. Go to Text tab > Text appearance.
- 4. From the Fill color drop-down, choose Background.
- 5. Confirm all windows with OK.

You asked, how do I hide behind an object in AutoCAD? Select objects that you want to hide from drawing then right click to bring the contextual menu and select Isolate then Hide objects.

Likewise, how do you put a background behind text in AutoCAD? You can easily add a background mask to the text. Double-click the text to begin editing the text. Then, in the Style panel of the Text Editor contextual ribbon, click the Background Mask button. The program displays the Background Mask dialog.

How do I put a box around text in AutoCAD?

To add a frame to text, select the text and then right-click and select Properties from the context menu. Scroll down the list of properties until you find the Text frame option. Select Yes from the Text frame option drop-down list.

What is text Mask in AutoCAD?

Text Mask allows to hide objects around a text with an empty area offset from the text by a specified value, to make the text more legible. You can create a Wipeout, a 3dface or a solid to mask objects around a text.

How do I make a background Mask?

How do you mask a block in AutoCAD?

- 1. If you have created your own mask block definition, create a tool from it.
- 2. If you are working with an existing mask block tool, open the palette it is located on.
- 3. Select the mask block tool on the palette.
- 4. Specify the insertion point of the mask block.
- 5. Continue adding mask blocks, and press Enter.

What is a wipeout in AutoCAD?

The Wipeout command is used to hide some parts of the drawing without deleting them. It is an object of the background color, the borders of which have a different color and can be hidden.

What is the difference between Hatch and BHatch?

Hatch was the original command line version. BHatch became the command that support dialog boxes.

How do I make text appear above the hatch in AutoCAD?

How do I remove a hatched area in AutoCAD?

1. Double-click the hatch pattern (not the hatch boundary).

- 2. The Hatch Editor will open. Click Pick Points.
- 3. Type S in the Command line and press Enter.
- 4. The cursor will turn into a pickbox. Select each of the internal areas where you want to remove the hatch.

Which icon is used to isolate or hide objects?

Click tab General panel Isolate Objects drop-down Hide Objects. Tip: You can also use the icon in the drawing window status to hide objects. A red icon () means that there are already objects hidden.

How do you hide a selection in AutoCAD?

- 1. At the command line, enter SELECTIONCYCLING (System Variable).
- 2. Enter 2 to turn on the selection cycling display window. Enter 0 to turn it off.

Where are the tools to isolate or hide objects in a drawing located?

- 1. Select the objects in the drawing that you want to isolate.
- 2. Right-click, and click Isolate Objects Isolate Selected Objects. Alternatively, you can click on the right side of the drawing window status bar, then click Isolate Objects, and select the objects you want to isolate.

How do I add a background mask to text attribute?

Double-click the attribute (text) and then click the ellipsis (â€l) as shown. You will now be taken to the text formatting editor. Right-click on the attribute (text) and select background mask from the menu as shown in Figure 3. Apply a background mask and select Use drawing background color as shown in Figure 4.

How do I mask a label in AutoCAD?

In the drawing, right-click a surface contour label and select Properties. Do one of the following: In the AutoCAD Properties palette, under Labels change the Masking property to From Label Style. This sets the contour label to the label background mask setting from the assigned label style.

How do I change the shape of a text frame in AutoCAD?

Check no for frames for the text in properties. Enter command TCIRCLE and check the options inside. You can create rectangles, slots and circles with this option.
