1. You can go to the Application Button Menu, select Import, and then select **SketchUp** or **FBX/OBJ** file, and open your chosen **file** with a double click.
2. Or you can use the Import SketchUp Object or **Import** FBX Object button in Stage 13: Yard Accessories in the Panel.

1. From the Main Menu bar, choose File > Import Into Level.
2. Select the FBX **file** containing the scene you wish to **import**.
3. Choose the destination folder in your Unreal project.

2. Select the **FBX** Asset.

Perhaps the file is newer than SU2018's importer can handle. If that's the case, you either need to save the dwg files back as an older version or get a newer version of SketchUp.

How do I convert FBX to prefab?

Right-click on an FBX or Prefab Asset file in the Project view and select Convert To FBX Prefab Variant from the context menu. Alternatively, you can use the main menu: Assets > Convert To FBX Prefab Variant.

How do I convert FBX to OBJ?

To convert FBX to OBJ 3D format, simply drag and drop a FBX file into the data upload area, specify the conversion options, click the "Convert" button, and get your output OBJ file in seconds.

What is SketchUp compatible with?

You can use SketchUp for Web on most internet-connected computers. We recommend using Chrome, Edge or Firefox updated to one of latest two major releases.

Can SketchUp open OBJ files?

Sketchup can open obj files if you have the right plugin. There are a number of plugins available, but the most popular one is the Sketchup STL Plugin. This plugin allows you to export your Sketchup models as STL files, which can then be opened in most 3D printing software programs. Yes, SketchUp can open OBJ files.

How do you explode in SketchUp?

To explode an entity, select it, context-click the selection, and choose Explode Curve from the menu that appears. In the figure, you see a polygon that's about to explode into its individual segments.

How do I change FBX to STL?

1. Open up Fusion 360, and click the "File" tab in the top-right corner.
2. Then click "Open" and choose your FBX model.
3. Once the model is loaded in, open the "File" tab again and click "Export".
4. Choose from STL from the available export formats.

How do I import a FBX file into Autocad?

1. Click Insert tab Import panel Import.
2. In the Import File dialog box, in the Files of type box, select FBX (*).
3. Find and select the FBX file you want to import, or enter the name of the FBX file at File Name.
4. Click Open.

How do you edit FBX?

Once you find the desired file, press the Import FBX button. Here is the original four-stair case that I want to change into a two-stair case. Press the middle-mouse button to rotate around your object. In the upper left dialog box, change Object Mode to Edit Mode.

Is FBX a good format?

A strength of the FBX file format, which is also shared by the OBJ 3D model format, is that it enables the storage of both position, UV and normal data that has different topology. This is great for high quality modeling tools, and enables complex features like accurate subdivision surfaces.

What is Trimble connect in SketchUp?

Trimble Connect 2.0 Extension for SketchUp lets you download files on demand from your online Trimble Connect folders directly into SketchUp, edit and re-upload those models to Trimble Connect, reference multiple collaborator models together, and more! Trimble Connect Sync is a stand-alone desktop application.

How do I add products to SketchUp?

1. Sign in to the 3D Warehouse.
2. From the user menu, select Manage Content.
3. Do one of the following:
4. Edit the .
5. Upload the .

How do I import a 3D Warehouse?

1. Tap on the Menu button. and choose Import and then From Trimble 3D Warehouse.
2. Find a model you want to import. You can navigate through the library as on a regular website, or use the search box.
3. Tap the Download button on the object page.

Can you convert SketchUp to AutoCAD?

Solution: To resolve the issue, download the add-on software for AutoCAD versions 2013 or newer from Autodesk App Store. Once the add-on is added, the ability to import SketchUp (. skp) file into AutoCAD will be available.

How do I convert 3d to 2d in SketchUp?

Can SketchUp export STEP files?

You need to export the sketchup file as a STI, then import and convert the mesh to a shape with freecad. Once complete, you can export the shape as a . STEP file.

What happened SketchUp 3D Warehouse?

Operating system aside, the 3D Warehouse is no longer converting newer files back to SketchUp 2018 or 2017 versions. You can still use the Components panel in SU2017 to find components that are already at the correct version, too.
