Introduction

Click Insert tab Import panel Map Import . In the Import Location dialog box, under Files Of Type, select Google KML. Select the file or folder to import. Click OK.

Also, can I **import** a **KMZ file** into AutoCAD? You can easily **import** a standard KML or KMZ file from Google Earth, from twiGIS or from other sources into your **AutoCAD** Map 3D or Civil 3D. The presumption is that the coordinate system is set correctly in your map (DWG drawing).

Best answer for this question, how do I convert a KMZ file to DWG?

1. Download and Install reaConverter.
2. Load **KMZ** Files.
3. Choose Output Folder.
4. Select DWG as Output Format.
5. Video tutorial.
6. Online KMZ to DWG converter.
7. Command-line interface.

In this regard, how do I convert KML to **Civil 3D**?

1. In the Toolspace, on the Toolbox tab, expand Miscellaneous Utilities Export KML.
2. On the General page of the Export KML wizard, specify place information for the file.
3. On the Objects page, specify the objects to export.

Additionally, how do I convert a KMZ to a shapefile?

1. Input KML **File**: Navigate to where your KML **file** is saved and select.
2. Output Location: Navigate to where you want your Layer file saved.
3. Output Data Name: If desired, specify a name for your layer file.

How do I upload a Google Earth image to Civil 3D?

In Civil 3D, from the IMAGINiT tab, within the Imagery/Terrain panel, select the Import from Google tool. You will need to zoom to the area of interest or enter the address to get to the right location. From the Import dialog you might pick the Fullscreen view option. Next, pick OK to attach the image to Civil 3D.

How do I import a KMZ file into AutoCAD 2021?

1. Click Insert tab Import panel Map Import .
2. In the Import Location dialog box, under Files Of Type, select Google KML.
3. Select the file or folder to import.
4. In the Import Dialog Box, under Spatial Filter, specify whether to limit the area where data will be imported:

How do I import Google Earth data into AutoCAD?

1. Step 1: Open Google Earth and create a placemark, path or polygon, or simply load an existing KML/KMZ file.
2. Step 2: Right-click on the polygon, and select 'Copy'.
3. Step 3: Open your AutoCAD drawing, right-click and select 'Clipboard' - 'Paste', or simply press Ctrl-V.

Can I import Google Earth into AutoCAD?

Can you convert a KMZ to a DXF?

Conversion from KMZ to DXF Upload your KMZ data (widely used in software like Google Earth and GPS devices) and convert them by one click to DXF (AutoCAD) format (widely used in software like AutoCAD, CorelDraw, 3d Studio Max and Maya).

How do I convert Google maps to AutoCAD?

First, you will need to capture the map and save the image. Then go to AutoCAD and click on **Insert**™ and scroll down and click on **Raster Image Reference**™ from the drop-down menu. You shall be directed to a list of saved files on your computer; search for the saved image, click on it and click open and click on **OK**.

What program opens KMZ files?

The Google Earth Pro desktop application is a common choice for opening KMZ files. To open a KMZ file with Google Earth Pro, select **File** → **Open**. You can also open a KMZ file in Google Maps by saving the KMZ file to an online location and then typing the URL in the Google Maps search box.

What is the difference between KML and KMZ?

KML is an open standard of the Open Geospatial Consortium (OGC). KML can include both raster and vector data, and the file includes symbolization. KML files are like HTML, and only contains links to icons and raster layers. A KMZ file combines the images with the KML into a single zipped file.

How do I export a KMZ file from Google Earth?

1. Open Google Earth.
2. Go to **File** → **Save Place As**.
3. In the new window, go to the left-hand panel and select a folder.
4. In the **File name** field, type the name of the file.
5. Click **Save**.
6. Google Earth will save the file as a . kmz file, which includes the KML file.

How do I convert KMZ to KML?

Figure 13.26: In Google Earth Pro, right-click the KMZ layer and choose **Save Place As**. In the dropdown menu of **Save file** window, choose **KML** format, as shown in Figure 13.27.

Can you convert a KML to a shapefile?

NOTE: You can also make features in google map and convert them into a KML. This allows you to then convert it into a shapefile.

What is the difference between KML and shapefile?

KML and Shapfiles could contain the exact same data, however KML is much more suited to displaying time based track information, whereas shapefiles are more suited to displaying Geometries, like boundaries, areas, roads, etc.

How do I extract a shapefile from Google Earth?

1. Go to a place on the map.
2. Above the map, click Add Path. To add a shape, click Add Polygon.
3. A "New Path" or "New Polygon" dialog will pop up.
4. To draw the line or shape you want, click a start point on the map and drag.
5. Click an endpoint.
6. Click OK.

How do I open Google Earth in Civil 3D?

How do I import a map into Civil 3D?

Solution: In the command line, type MAPSTATUSBAR and choose "show". A new item will appear at the status bar in bottom of your screen, click the small triangle and choose "Library" to select your coordinate system, which will now be set in the drawing.
