Introduction

Open the RFA **file** in Revit (e.g. by simple drag-n-drop) and using the menu R > File > Export > CAD formats choose export to the format DWG , DXF or DGN or SAT. You can specify other export options and complete the conversion.

Additionally, how do I install an RFA **file**?

1. Click **Insert** tab Load from Library panel (Load Family).
2. In the Load Family dialog, double-click the category of the family that you want to load.
3. Preview any of the families (**RFA**) in the category: To preview a single family, select it from the list.
4. Select the family that you want to load, and click Open.

Subsequently, can I import Revit file to **AutoCAD**? No. Revit must export to DWG first.

Frequent question, how do I open an RFA file?

1. Click on 'Product Trial' on the main menu to the far left.
2. Select your language on the next page with the drop down menu.

3. Follow the prompts and instructions to install the software.
4. Open the software. Click **File** in the main menu bar. Scroll down and click **Open**.
5. Browse for your **.rfa** file.

Quick Answer, how do I XREF a Revit file in AutoCAD? RFA is a file extension assigned to Revit Family Files, a file type designed specifically for the BIM Modeling Software Autodesk Revit. Revit families are a group of 2D and 3D digital components that aid in the development of **.RVT**s (Revit Project Files).

How do I open a RFA file without Revit?

1. Use the free online A360 Viewer.
2. Download the free Design Review 2013 and export the Revit model as a DWF.
3. Use the Revit viewer mode.
4. If you have Navisworks, you can open the Revit file in Navisworks, then save as an NWD file.

How do I convert an RVT file?

Can SketchUp open RFA files?

No. The RVT and RFA file formats are proprietary to Autodesk, so the only way is to export from Revit to a file format Sketchup can understand.

How do I import an RFA file into Revit?

1. Select the command.
2. Select the file to import.
3. Specify the import information, and click OK.

How do I open an RFA file in archicad?

1. Go to File > Libraries and Objects > Import RFA as GDL Object
2. Select the RFA file to import and click Open.
3. In the Import RFA as GDL Object dialogue box verify or adjust import settings and click Import.
4. In the Information dialogue box, click OK.

How do I export Revit to DWG?

1. Click File tab Export CAD Formats (DWG) or (DXF).

2. In the DWG (or DXF) Export dialog, for Select Export Setup, select the desired setup.
3. Select the views and sheets to export.
4. If you are ready to export, click Next.

How do I export from Revit to AutoCAD 2d?

1. Navigate to the target folder for the exported files.
2. For Files of type, select an AutoCAD version for the exported DWG/DXF file.
3. For Naming, select an option for the automatically generated file name.

Does Revit use XREF?

When you import or link the DWG file, Revit displays the geometry from the nested xrefs. The decision to import or link a file to a Revit project affects what you can do with the xref information: If you import the file, you can explode the nested xrefs to Revit elements.

What is an RTE file?

Project template created with Revit, a 3D building design program; contains building information modeling (BIM) information and is used for creating multiple project (. RVT) files with a similar layout. NOTE: Since RTE files are templates, you cannot overwrite them.

How do I open a STP file?

1. Find the STEP file on your computer or device.
2. Double click or right-click and select File > Open.
3. Your file will open with the associated STEP reading software already installed, like Adobe Acrobat.

What format are Revit files?

1. Revit native formats: RVT, RFA, RTE, RFT.
2. CAD formats: DGN, DWF, DWG, DXF, IFC, SAT, and SKP.
3. Image formats: BMP, PNG, JPG, JPEG, and TIF.
4. Other formats: ODBC, HTML, TXT, and gbXML.

What programs can open RFA file?

1. Autodesk AutoCAD Architecture.
2. Autodesk Revit Structure.
3. Autodesk MEP.

Can Autodesk Viewer open Revit files?

Note: Revit Family files (RFA) are unable to be uploaded to Autodesk Viewer currently.

1. All in a View.
2. Autodesk Viewer.
