



# How to insert symbols in microstation?

## Introduction

To place non-keyboard text **symbols** in MicroStation, use the **Insert Symbol** icon in the **MicroStation Text Editor**. This brings up a dialog showing all of the symbols available for the active font. This listing is identical to what can be found in the Windows Character Map.

Beside above, how do you make a degree symbol in MicroStation? When using a True Type Font (TTF) in MicroStation and you place the degree symbol (  $^{\circ}$  ), MicroStation will use ASCII code #0176 which is the standard code for all Unicode based fonts.

Furthermore, how do you type in **MicroStation**?

Subsequently, how do I add text in **MicroStation V8i**? In MicroStation V8 XM Edition, you can edit text in cells using either the Word Processor, Dialog box or the WYSIWYG interface. And finally, in MicroStation V8i, just double-click the text with the Element Selection tool. This automatically activates the Edit Text tool. It can’t get any easier than that!

Quick Answer, how do you write fractions in MicroStation?

1. Select Text Styles (Drawing > Annotate > Text).
2. On the General tab, turn on Fractions.

3. Select the Place Text tool.
4. In the Text Editor window, key in the numerator, then a  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$  or  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$  character, then the denominator (for example 1/2 ) and then press .

Go to Settings > Design File > Working Units and change the master unit label to  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$  or double quotes for the representation of the Inch mark.

## How do I change text attributes in MicroStation?

1. Select or fence the text or tag element(s).
2. Select the Change Text Attributes tool.
3. Accept the change.

## How do I open text editor in MicroStation?

The easiest way to open the Text Editor window is to double-click on an existing text element with the Element Selection tool. Double-clicking opens the Text Editor window.

## How do I change text node in MicroStation?

1. Enable  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$ Text Nodes $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$  from Drawing > View > Presentation > View Attributes.
2. Double click to select/edit the empty text node (Or activate the  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$ Edit Text $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$  tool, and select the empty text node).
3. Enter text in the subsequently launched Text Editor.
4. Place text in the view.

## How do I edit data fields in MicroStation?

1. From the Text task, select the Edit Text tool.
2. Click on the enter data field in the design file. The Word Processor opens.
3. Double-click the enter data field in the word processor.
4. Make the desired changes to the enter data field character, restrict the length and/or justification and click OK.

## Can not edit text in MicroStation?

1. Go to: Workspace > Preferences.
2. Under the Category list > choose Text.
3. From the  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$ Text Editor Style $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$  > change  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$ Word Processor $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$  to  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$ Dialog Box $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$
4. Click  $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$ OK $\frac{\text{a}}{\text{b}}$

5. Then go to File > File Settings.

## How do you underline text in MicroStation?

1. Start Edit text tool (or double click on a text element).
2. In Text Editor dialog, select the text you want to underline.
3. Switch underline on (Ctrl+U can be used in the dialog)
4. Open Text Styles dialog (using magnifier icon).
5. Set a proper underline spacing value and press Activate button.

## How do you justify text in MicroStation?

## How do you set units in MicroStation?

Working units are changed using the design file settings dialog box. This dialog can be accessed from the main menu under Settings > Design File. In this dialog box, choose the "Working units" entry from the list on the far left. Both the master and the sub units can now be changed.

## How do you put arrows in MicroStation?

To place an arrow marker Select the Place Arrow Marker tool. The Place Arrow Marker settings window opens. Choose the desired reference number, sheet number, and arrow direction to appear in the arrow marker. Enter a data point to define the center of the detail circle.

## How do I use Match element attributes in MicroStation?

1. Go to the Change Attribute tool.
2. Click on eyedropper(Match Element Attributes)
3. Select the attributes you want to match by checking appropriate boxes.
4. Select new element to apply the attributes from first element.

## How do you hatch in MicroStation?

To hatch around text inside of a closed element use the Flood method, select the down arrow in the lower right corner of the Tool Settings window to "Show Extended Settings". Select the Locate Interior Text icon. Using this option will cause the hatching to go around the text within the closed element.

## How do you match dimension attributes?

1. Select the Match Dimension Settings tool.
2. Identify the dimension element.
3. Accept the new active dimension settings.

## How do you expand a text box in MicroStation?

1. Grab one of the corner angle handles and drag for resizing the dialog. 2. Double click on the text and you will see that the ruler is now longer.
