1. Download all of the material pack's zip files according to which renderer(s) you will need.
2. Use a zip utility capable of opening linked zips.
3. OSX.
4. Use the zip utility to extract the first zip file of a given set.

How do I import a PNG into Cinema 4D?

C4D is a 3D program – pngs are 2D images, so to get a 2D image – to C4D you need to assign it to a 3D object as a texture via a material. Make a plane primitive, make it the same size with the properties as the aspect ratio of your png, then make a material and add the png to the texture slot of the colour channel.

How do I import FBX into Cinema 4D?

1. Open the Cinema 4D file.
2. In Cinema 4D choose File->Export->FBX 6.0.
3. Place the exported fbx file in the Unity project's Assets folder. Unity will now automatically import the fbx file.

What's a lib4d file?

Library created by Cinema 4D, a professional application that enables you to create 3D models and animations; contains one or more presets that can be inserted into a scene by the user; includes pre-defined or custom made objects such as images, pencil marks, skies, brick shaders, body paint gradients, and 3D balloons.
