As for the timing, lumion is generally speaking faster than Vray, one render takes seconds to minutes while Vray take a bit longer in render if you want higher quality and this is due to the fact that the render in Lumion is by default, while the one with Vray is personalized according to the needs of users.

What is Vismat file?

Vismats and VRmats are Material Presets that are only compatible with the V-ray renderer. In V-Ray 3.0, VRmats has been introduced as a new extension format. Clara.io comes with a huge Vismat Material library. To view the list of available Vismat Materials in Clara.io, go to Render > Materials > Vray.

How do I import Vismat into Vray?

Open the Vray material editor and find the material you want to replace with the . vismat. Right click on it and choose import material.

How do you import textures?

In the Textures panel (Window Media Control Panels Textures), click the Import Texture button. In the Import Texture dialog box, browse to the folder where the texture is stored. Choose a texture, and click Open.

How do I import SKM files into SketchUp?

Find the Sketchup 2016 folder and then the Sketchup application file. Right-click on it as shown below and choose "Show Package Contentsâ€. From there go into Contents->Resources->Content->Materials and place your folder of . SKM materials into there with the other default materials.
