

How to join 2 objects in sketchup?

Millions of engineers and designers in tens of thousands of companies use Sketchup. It is one of the most widely used design and engineering programs and is used by many different professions and companies around the world because of its wide range of features and excellent functionality. Introduction

Select the **Join** tool (), which you find on the default toolbar or by selecting Tools > Join. Click an edge in each piece with the Join tool cursor. A blue outline flashes as you click, and the shape begins to inherit the fill color of the first shape that you click.

Correspondingly, how do you intersect a shape in SketchUp? Context-click the cutting shape, and choose Intersect Faces > With Model from the menu that appears. The command tells SketchUp to create edges where the two shapes intersect. With the Eraser tool (), erase or move the geometry that you don't want to keep.

Best answer for this question, can you group **objects** in **SketchUp**? In LayOut, groups are a way to keep related elements organized in the drawing area. Groups can also make selecting and copying multiple elements easier. For example, if you know you'll always want to select a text box and a shape together, make it a group so you just need to select it once.

Frequent question, how do you link components in **SketchUp**?

1. Open the model into which you want to import a SketchUp file.
2. Select File > Import.
3. In the Open dialog box that appears, navigate to the SketchUp file.
4. Select the SketchUp file, and click Open.
5. Click in the drawing area to place the component in your model.

Here's what all three modes do:

- *Intersect Faces with Model*: Creates edges everywhere your selected faces intersect with other faces in your model – whether the other faces are selected or not.

How do I make a solid group in SketchUp?

1. Open SketchUp.
2. Create two separate grouped objects:
3. Click on a Group and open the Entity Window by clicking Window>Entity Info.
4. Move the groups together so that they intersect each other.
5. Select both groups and CTRL+click on them.
6. Select both Groups and CTRL+click.

What is difference between group and component in SketchUp?

By definition, a Group is a single instance of a collection of geometry. A Component is a named collection of geometry that can exist at multiple locations within the model. Each instance is a repetition of all others. A change to one instance changes all other instances.

How do you add objects to a group?

1. Click (regular left-click) the group of 3.
2. Hold the shift key down while clicking the 4th object. By holding shift down you're telling the computer you want all objects to be active (or selected).
3. Release the mouse, and on the keyboard press Ctrl+G.

How do I add an object to a component in SketchUp?

After right clicking and selecting "edit component", the bearings are grayed out. That means you drew them outside the component. Close it, select a bearing and copy or cut. Then open the component for edit and paste in place.

What is explode in SketchUp?

The explode feature breaks an entity into its segments, so that you can select one segment separately from the others. To explode an entity, select it, context-click the selection, and choose Explode Curve from the menu that appears.

How do I create a dynamic component in SketchUp?

1. Select the component you want to make dynamic.
2. On the Dynamic Components toolbar, click the Component Attributes tool () or select Window > Component Attributes.
3. Click the Add Attribute plus sign icon to see a list of options.

How do you join a surface in SketchUp?

Select the Join tool (), which you find on the default toolbar or by selecting Tools > Join. Click an edge in each piece with the Join tool cursor. A blue outline flashes as you click, and the shape begins to inherit the fill color of the first shape that you click.

How does intersect faces work in SketchUp?

1. Just select one of the objects, move it by pressing the quick-key "m" and place it on the other as you require.
2. Select both objects, right click and select the "Intersect Faces" tab. Here you have two options.
3. And there you have it. We have successfully mated a sphere with a cube.

What is plug weld joint?

Plug welds are a round weld that is made inside of an existing hole most commonly in one piece of metal, welding that piece to another member. The plug weld symbol is a rectangle with a diameter symbol placed to the left of the symbol as well as the number associated with that diameter.

Why is my object not a solid SketchUp?

In order for SketchUp of any version to consider something a solid, it must be a group or component. The group or component must contain only geometry—no other groups or components—and every edge in the group or component must be shared by exactly two faces. No more and no less.

How do you hollow an object in SketchUp?

1. Erase the interior to make your design hollow inside: Click on the black “selection” arrow at the far upper right corner of the menu. Then right click the interior of the circle. Click “Erase.” You should remain with a hollow “o” or “donut-style” shape.

How do I organize groups in SketchUp?
