Introduction

Best answer for this question, how do you combine dimensions in AutoCAD?

1. Click Annotate tab Dimension panel drop-down Join. Find.
2. Select the base dimension (1).
3. Select the dimensions to **join** to the base **dimension** (2).
4. Press ENTER.

Subsequently, how do you **join** objects in AutoCAD?

1. Select the Join command from the ribbon panel under the Modify interface. Or. Type J or join on the command line and press Enter.
2. We need to select multiple objects to join. The selected objects are joined at once.
3. Press Enter.

Additionally, how do you explode a line group in AutoCAD? Ctrl+shift+A and see if it helps. Cntl+Shift+A is the **AutoCAD** shortcut for turning Groups on and off. In Help search for "Shortcut Keys

Reference to see other shortcuts that are built into AutoCAD.

As many you asked, how do I use the **Explode** tool in **AutoCAD**? Ctrl + select the two size dimensions from left to right. Right-click and click **Combine Dimension**. The dimensions combine into one at the last selected dimension, with an instance count automatically added.

How do I match dimension properties in AutoCAD?

Hit Ma command select dimension and then select the dimension to match the properties of previous selected.

How do you join two blocks in AutoCAD?

Import all blocks individually with **Insert** and put the hook at **origin**. After that use the command **BLOCK** and select all Objects.. Then you should be able to combine them all to one Block.

How do you join two lines in AutoCAD?

1. Click Home tab Modify panel Edit Polyline. Find.
2. Select a polyline, spline, line, or arc to edit.
3. Enter j (Join).
4. Select one or more polylines, splines, lines, or arcs that are located end to end.
5. Press Enter to end the command.

What's the opposite of explode on AutoCAD?

There is no **unexplode**: you can use **BLOCK** command or **BEDIT** command to make a new block. Hi, the command you are looking for is **join**, it will connect all the lines you select. To execute this command you need to turn all the lines you want to join into polylines if they aren't already.

What is the difference between burst and explode in AutoCAD?

BURST is best used any time you need to explode a block or object but would like to preserve the Attribute values of the block instead of reverting them back to the default value. If you were to use the **EXPLODE** command, the block layers are also preserved when using the **BURST** command.

How do you explode an array in AutoCAD?

How do I enable explode block in AutoCAD?

1. Use the icon in the modify tab.
2. Type the shortcut command X(explode) from the command line and enter.
3. Explode blocks while inserting. (Tick the check box)

How do I join a rectangle in AutoCAD?

1. Click Home tab Modify panel Join. Find.
2. Select a source object or select multiple objects to join together.
3. Valid objects include lines, arcs, elliptical arcs, polylines, 3D polylines, and splines.

What is the Explode feature AutoCAD?

You can convert a complex entity, such as a block or polyline, from a single entity into its component parts. Exploding a polyline, rectangle, donut, polygon, dimension, or leader reduces it to a collection of individual line and arc entities that you can then modify individually.

Why explode is used in AutoCAD?

Breaks a compound object into its component objects. Explodes a compound object when you want to modify its components separately. Objects that can be exploded include blocks, polylines, and regions, among others.

How do you automatically add dimensions in AutoCAD?

Select a dimension or multileader. Enter a (Auto) and press Enter.

How do you join dimensions in Revit?

1. Select the dimensions that need to be aligned/joined.
2. Click on the Join Dimension Lines command. If there is no selection, you are asked to make the selection of dimension lines.
3. As a result, all the parallel dimension lines are joined to form a single chain dimension line.

How do you match dimension text in AutoCAD?

1. Click Home tab Annotation panel Dimension Style.
2. In the Dimension Style Manager, select the style you want to change.
3. In the Modify Dimension Style dialog box, Text tab, under Text Appearance, select a text style.

How do you match a property?

1. Click Home tab > Properties panel > Match Properties. Find.

2. Select the object from which you want to copy properties.
3. If you want to specify which properties are copied, enter s (Settings).
4. Select the objects to which you want to copy the properties, and press Enter.

What is Donut command in AutoCAD?

A donut consists of two arc polylines that are joined end-to-end to create a circular shape. The width of the polylines is determined by the specified inside and outside diameters. If you specify an inside diameter of 0, the donut is a filled circle. The following prompts are displayed. Inside Diameter.
