In this regard, how do I permanently dock a command line in **AutoCAD**? Solution: **The** way to resolve it is to re-dock it, Open Options, go to Profiles Tab and see what is the current profile being used, then close **AutoCAD** (or verticals).

As many you asked, how do I anchor a command line in AutoCAD? Dock the **Command** Window “ Click and hold **the** mouse button over the grip on the left edge of the command window and drag the window to a new location at the top or bottom edge of the drawing window. Release the mouse button when **the** command window arrives.

Additionally, how do I **lock** my toolbar in AutoCAD?

People ask also, how do I undock **command** line in AutoCAD? To collapse **the** command line (like other palettes such as the Properties window or **the** Tool Palettes), first undock it by dragging its gray title bar at the left. Then right-click **the** gray title bar and choose Auto-Hide. The **command** line palette collapses to a small gray bar. That’s pretty small!

Docking the Command Window A docked command window is the same width as the application window. It is displayed in a fixed location above or below the drawing area. Drag the command window to dock or undock. The command window is docked by default for certain operating systems and Windows themes.

How do you lock the command bar in Civil 3d?

To add it to the Status bar, click the Customization (menu) button (3 lines at the far right of the status bar) and select Lock UI. The button-menu can then be clicked to lock and unlock UI items.

Docking the Command Window You can undock a command window by double-clicking it. You can dock it by dragging it to the top or bottom edge of the drawing area. The command window is docked by default for certain operating systems and Windows themes.

How do you turn off dynamic input in AutoCAD?

1. Press the F12 key to toggle Dynamic Input on and off.
2. Change the DYNMODE variable to 1 for on, or 0 for off.
3. Toggle the dynamic input icon in the lower-left or lower-right corner of the program:

What is command line window in AutoCAD?

The command line is where you will see instructions and options when using commands. For example, on the Home ribbon, in the Draw panel, click the Line tool. On the command line, the program prompts you to specify the first point of the line. Once you click to pick that point, the prompt changes.

How do I turn on the ribbon in AutoCAD?

1. RIBBON to show/turn on the ribbon on.
2. RIBBONCLOSE to hide/turn the ribbon off.

How do I reset my AutoCAD toolbar?

From the AutoCAD menu, click Preferences. In Preferences, click the Application tab. Click the Reset Application Options button. Click Reset AutoCAD.

How do I create a floating bar in AutoCAD?

1. Run the CUI command.
2. Right Click the Toolbars section, and select New Toolbar.
3. Give the toolbar a name.
4. Click and drag commands from the section below up into the toolbar name. It will show a little blue arrow when its going to add them to the toolbar.
5. Select Apply to add the toolbar in the AutoCAD workspace.

What is offset command in AutoCAD?

The offset command in AutoCAD is used to create parallel lines, concentric circles, and parallel curves. We can offset any object through a point or at a specified distance. We can create as many parallel lines and curves with the help of the offset command.

How does extend command work in AutoCAD?

The extend command is used to extend the selected boundaries or edges. The objects are extended so that the edges of other objects can be converged. It displays the effect of the Extend command on the figure.

Re: MOVING COMMAND LINE TO TOP The first step is to enter ISPF Option 0. The COMMAND LINE AT BOTTOM should be blank. If that is done, go into Quick Edit and enter SETTINGS. The ISPF OPTIONS panel should be displayed.

To Dock the Ribbon in a New Location If it is not undocked, undock the ribbon. Click the title bar and drag the undocked ribbon to either the left edge, right edge, or top of the drawing area. When the

outline of the window is displayed in the docking area, release the button.
