1. Drag a pyramid onto workplane and set its size to 40*45mm and height to 100mm.
2. Drag a ball and set its size to 70.87*62mm.
3. Create 3 duplicates and align them at the edge of the pyramid in all the directions.
4. Add a round roof and set its size to 65.25*26mm.
