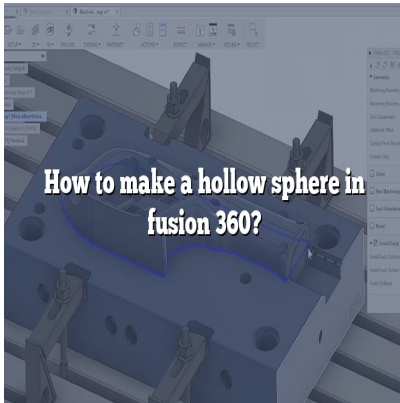




How to make a hollow sphere in fusion 360?

Subsequently, how do you make a hollow shape in Fusion 360? In the Combine dialogue box, click on Target Body and select the top half of the object. Then click on Tool Body and select the bottom half of the object. Now click OK and your combined shape will look like this – a hollow cube!

1. In the Design workspace, on the Mesh tab, select Modify > Shell . The Shell dialog displays.
2. In the canvas, select a mesh body.
3. In the dialog, specify the Thickness value.
4. Click OK.

Which tool hollows out a solid model and removes one or more faces?

The shell tool hollows out a part, leaves open the faces you select, and creates thin-walled features on the remaining faces. If you do not select any face on the model, you can shell a solid part, creating a closed, hollow model.

How do you fillet in Fusion 360?

1. Click Design > Solid > Modify > Fillet .
2. In the dialog, from the Type dropdown list, select Rule Fillet.
3. Select a Rule to create fillets on all edges in a single selection set, or only at shared edges of two selection sets:
4. In the canvas, select faces or features to fillet.

1. In the Design workspace, Form contextual environment, select Create > Loft .
2. In the canvas, select two or more Profiles to loft.
3. In the Loft dialog, select an end condition or continuity for the first and last profiles:

Use sharp scissors to cut your paper into 12 strips that are 1½-inch (1.25 centimeters) wide and 6 inches (15.25 centimeters) long. Punch holes through both ends of the strips. Evenly stack the strips of

paper. Punch a hole on either end of the stack using a standard hole punch.

Fusion 360 is an excellent choice for creating models for 3D printing. It allows you to create not only “prismatic” models such as gears or brackets, but it also allows you create more “organic” models using T-Splines, including characters, plants, and vehicles.

How do you make a solid box in Fusion 360?

1. On the toolbar, click Solid > Create > Box .
2. In the canvas, select a plane or planar face.
3. Place the first corner of the box.
4. Place the opposite corner, or specify exact Length and Width values, to define the base of the box.

Autodesk Fusion 360 is the first 3D CAD, CAM, CAE, and PCB tool of its kind, connecting your entire product development process into one cloud-based software.

How do you make a hollow circle on shape?

1. Tap Shell tool.
2. Optionally, toggle Hollow to shell (hollow) the part without removing any faces.
3. Select Faces to remove.
4. Specify Shell thickness.
5. Optionally, toggle to switch to the Opposite direction.
6. Tap the checkmark.

Which tool is good to make a hollow in a solid object?

The Hollow tool is used to create internal cavities inside closed solids, with a consistent wall thickness.

How do you make a hollow solidworks cylinder?

1. Select the front face of the cylinder by clicking on the circumference.
2. Click Exit Sketch, then select the smaller circle by clicking on the circumference.
3. Select Extrude Cut, and in the Property Manager that appears on the left of your screen, make D1 60mm.
