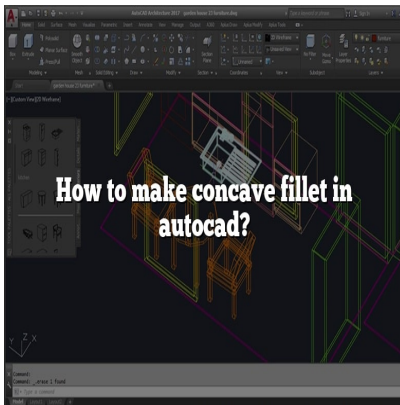




# How to make concave fillet in autocad?

## Introduction

You asked, how do you reverse a fillet in AutoCAD? Right-click on the misbehaving polyline and select Polyline > Reverse (or type Reverse) and fillet again. •This trick works in all versions of AutoCAD since 2010. •

Likewise, how do you create a fillet in AutoCAD?

1. Select the Fillet command from the ribbon panel. Or.
2. Type M or Multiple on the command line.
3. Press Enter.
4. Select the first object.
5. Type R or Radius on the command line.
6. Press Enter.
7. Specify the fillet radius. For example, 1.
8. Press Enter.

Moreover, how do I fillet a circle in AutoCAD? To fillet objects: Click FILLET. or enter F in the Command line. Choose Radius in the command options, enter a radius, and press Enter. This number will be the radius of the arc between the two objects you fillet.

Additionally, how do you fillet a solid object in AutoCAD?

1. Click Solid tab Solid Editing panel Fillet Edge. Find.
2. Select the edge of the solid to fillet.
3. Specify the fillet radius.
4. Select additional edges or press Enter.

## How do I create a chamfer in AutoCAD?

1. Select Chamfer icon from the drop-down list of Fillet, as shown below:
2. Type A or Angle on the command line.
3. Press Enter.
4. Specify the length of Chamfer on the first line and press Enter.
5. Specify Angle value and press Enter.

## How do you make a curved corner in AutoCAD?

We can use the Fillet command to “cut corners” and “round” our edges without doing any math. Once we specify our corner’s radius, the command will automatically join both lines to each other. The “Multiple” option allows us to continuously Fillet many intersections without having to initiate the command repeatedly.

## How do you fillet a curve and a line?

1. Choose Curve Edit > Create > Curve Fillet .
2. In the option window, select the Construction Type and other fillet options.
3. Click the first curve on the fillet side.
4. Click Build.
5. For overlapping curves, to change the fillet quadrant, drag the circular dots and click Update.

## How do I chamfer a circle in AutoCAD?

1. Click Solid tab Solid Editing panel Chamfer Edge. Find.
2. Select the edge to chamfer. A preview of the chamfer is displayed.
3. Do one of the following:
4. Specify the distances for the base surface and the other, adjacent surface.

5. Do one of the following:
6. To complete the chamfer, press Enter.

## What is the difference between chamfer and fillet in AutoCAD?

What is the Difference between a Fillet and Chamfer? Fillets describe rounded corners of a design (or part) that help to reduce stresses and prevent rapid deformation at the corners of the part. In contrast, chamfers are sloped or angled edges (usually at 45° or 60° ) of a design or part.

## How do you Fillet in Solid Edge?

1. Click Solids > Solid Editing > Fillet edges (or type FilletEdges).
2. Specify the Radius option.
3. Specify the radius of the fillet arc.
4. Specify the edges of 3D solids and press Enter. The software fillets the edges by the specified radius.

## How do you chamfer a solid?

1. On the ribbon, choose Edit > Chamfer (in Modify).
2. On the menu, choose Modify > Chamfer.
3. On the Modify toolbar, click the Chamfer tool.
4. Type chamfer and then press Enter.
5. To select a different surface, type n and press Enter.
6. To use the current surface, press Enter.

## What is loft in AutoCAD?

The loft command in AutoCAD is used to create 3D solid or surface. The 3D solid or surface is formed within the space between various cross sections. The cross-sections determine the outer shape of the solid or surface. To create a 3D object using LOFT, we are required to specify at least two cross-sections.

## How do you use a fillet command?

**First Object** Select the second object or line segment of a 2D polyline to define the fillet. You can also hold down the Shift key before selecting the second object or line segment of a 2D polyline to extend or trim the selected objects to form a sharp corner.

## How do I draw a smooth curve in AutoCAD?

1. Click Home tab Draw panel Polyline. Find.
2. Specify the start point of the polyline segment.
3. Specify the endpoint of the polyline segment.
4. Specify additional polyline segments as needed.
5. Press Enter to end, or enter c to close the polyline.
