



# How to make mirror in 3d max vray?

## Description

3ds Max is a 3D modeling software that employs polygon modeling. Polygon modeling allows users to exert precise control over individual meshes using X, Y, and Z coordinates, which appear as a collection of vertices, edges, and faces.

The user frequently starts with a simple extruded item or a primitive shape. The shape is then defined further by adding details, such as modifying existing surfaces.

## Introduction

Subsequently, how do you make a mirror in Max?

1. Create a plane or a box or any geometry with flat surfaces.
2. Open material editor and click on the diffuse spot of any empty slot.
3. Select flat mirror form the new material library.
4. Apply material to the geometry.
5. Now, create any object in front of the geometry or the mirror.
6. Render.

To make the material transparent, set the Refract option to very close to white. The white color indicates that this material is fully refractive. In real world no glass material is fully reflective or fully refractive, and the same goes for glossiness.

**How do you create a reflection in SketchUp?**

1. Right click on a face which use the material, and select IRender: Edit Material.
2. This will load the Material Wizard .
3. Select the Reflective material type from the defaults on the left.
4. Use the slider bar to select the reflection desired.

**How do you make a glass effect in SketchUp?**

1. Reflective Glass: 30 to 49.
2. Mostly Reflective : 50 to 75.
3. Slightly Reflective: 76 to 90.
4. Mostly Transparent: 91 to 96.

5. Transparent: 96 to 100.

## How can you create a mirrored copy of an object in AutoCAD?

The mirror command in AutoCAD is used to create a copy (mirror copy) of the selected object. We can also delete the source object after mirroring the object. The objects that represent the same as the half of their object can be mirrored across a center line to create the other half of the object.

## Is there a mirror tool on SketchUp?

Using the Flip Along Command to Mirror In SketchUp you can use the Flip Along command to mirror objects. The process is, as described above “easier” and can be used for all sorts of objects.

## Where is the flip command in SketchUp?

To flip your geometry, follow these steps: With the Select tool ( ), select the geometry you want to flip. Context-click your selection and select Flip Along. In the submenu, select an axis.

## What is refraction VRAY?

Refraction Glossiness simulates a rougher surface, by diffusing the light rays in different directions. Lower values create a rougher look (frosted or sand-blasted glass, or textured rough plastic), and higher values are for smooth surfaces.
