Also know, why is my SketchUp object not solid? In order for SketchUp of any version to consider something a solid, it must be a group or component. The group or component must contain only geometry“no other groups or components”and every edge in the group or component must be shared by exactly two faces. No more and no less.

Moreover, how do you fill an object in SketchUp?

1. With the Select tool (), select the shape in the drawing area.
2. Open the Shape Style panel by clicking its title bar.
3. Click the Fill option, which becomes highlighted, as shown in the following figure.

Also, how do I know if a SketchUp model is solid? The only way currently to verify “solid” in the web version is to make your object a group/component as is usual. Hi everyone, As of today, subscribers can use Solid Inspector in SketchUp for Web to review groups and components, examine errors in solid geometry, and automatically fix some problems.

Why won’t my shapes fill in in Sketchup?

The best would be to redraw making sure you keep edges on axis as you go. The other thing you want to get in the habit of is making sure face orientation is correct. The blue indicates the faces are reversed.

How do you fill an irregular shape in Sketchup?

One way would be to select them and then hit Edit>Hide. Another way would be to hold Shift while clicking on them with the Eraser tool. Awesome!

What is solid object in SketchUp?

In SketchUp, a solid is any 3D model (component or group) that has a finite closed volume. A SketchUp solid cannot have any leaks (missing faces or faces that do not meet at an edge).

How do you know if an object is solid?

Something is usually described as a solid if it can hold its own shape and is hard to compress (squash). The particles in most solids are closely packed together. Even though the particles are locked into place and cannot move or slide past each other, they still vibrate a tiny bit.

How do you make something hollow in SketchUp?

1. Erase the interior to make your design hollow inside: Click on the black "selection" arrow at the far upper right corner of the menu. Then right click the interior of the circle. Click "Erase."
 - You should remain with a hollow "or donut-style" shape.

How do you make a curved solid in SketchUp?

Use the Push/pull tool and pull it out to the width that you want it. Hold down CTRL, click on the Eraser tool and erase the lines that you see on the top and the bottom so the surface is "smooth". Move away from the first shape, and start work on another one. Create another set of arcs.

How do I change a wireframe to a solid in SketchUp?

If you're using SketchUp Web (the free version), which doesn't have the menu bar at the top, you can click on Styles (it should be on the right-hand menu bar) > Default Styles, and then select which style you want. Hope this helped!

You can also select the Pan tool () by selecting View > Pan. With the Pan tool active, click and drag the Pan cursor in any direction to pan around the document area.

1. Select the shape or text box.
2. On the Drawing Tools Format tab, click Shape Fill > More Fill Colors.
3. In the Colors box, either click the color you want on the Standard tab, or mix your own color on the Custom tab.
