1. Select the Sandbox From Scratch tool () on the Sandbox toolbar, or select Draw > Sandbox > From Scratch from the menu bar.
2. Click to set the TIN's starting point.

| Windows: Select Window > Default Tray > Soften Edges. Or context-click your selection and choose Soften/Smooth Edges. Either way, the Soften Edges dialog box appears, as shown in the figure. Click and drag the Angle between normals slider to set the maximum size of all angles that will be smoothed or softened.

Drawing curved lines With the Line tool (), click and drag to draw the line. As you drag, a curvature control extends from the start point. Release the mouse button, and without clicking, move the cursor to set the curve's direction and size, as shown on the left in the following figure.

1. Blind Contour. "Blind contour drawing" is when contour drawing is done without looking at the paper AT ALL.
2. Continuous Line Contour.
3. Modified Contour.

What are 3 types of contour lines?

There are 3 kinds of contour lines you'll see on a map: intermediate, index, and supplementary. Index lines are the thickest contour lines and are usually labeled with a number at one point along the line.

How do I free terrain in SketchUp?

How do you simplify contours in SketchUp?

1. If you have a cad file with the topo lines at the right height each, simply import it to SketchUp (File > Import > Select DWG as the file format)

2. Then select the topo lines in SketchUp and click on the "from Contours" button in the Sandbox Tool Bar.

How do you do smooth contours?

1. Select a contour line style for your surface representing an adequate equidistance.
2. Make sure that the contour line style has switched on "line smoothing."
3. Select the surface and extract the contour lines with border.

What is contour model in architecture?

Stepped contours consist of cutting out multiple layers of material such as card, veneer, MDF and ply, and then laminating them together to form the landscape. Choosing the thickness of the material to give the correct step for each change of contour is crucial. Usually the steps are every 1m.

What is contour in architecture?

It is the line on a plan or map that represents those points that have the same height, that is to say, they have the same altitude, in relation to a reference plan. They must not intersect or coincide, except in vertical walls and cornices, as the higher they are the less developed they are.

How do you make a 3d topographic map?

1. 1 Get digital elevation data for the area you wish to model. You will typically download that data as a GeoTiff file.
2. 2 If necessary, crop the section of interest from the larger dataset.
3. 3 Convert that data to a DEM file.
4. 4 Make a 3d model based on the data.
5. 5 Print and enjoy.

The most common materials used for paving roads are asphalt and concrete. Factors such as cost and amount of traffic will determine which material is used. Asphalt uses an oil-based substance called bitumen to make sand and crushed rock stick together like glue.
