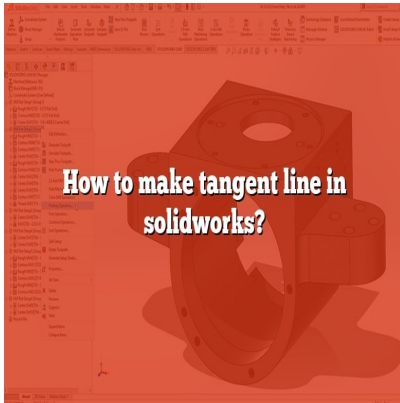




How to make tangent line in solidworks?

Best answer for this question, how do you show a tangent **line** in **SolidWorks** drawing?

Beside above, how do you create a tangent relationship in SolidWorks? Starting the line from an arc or circle may not add the tangent relation automatically. However you can hover over the arc to “wake up” the center point, start the line on the arc and drag the line out in the **tangent** direction. You can even spin it around the curve and it will remain tangent.

Furthermore, how do you arc and **line tangent** in SolidWorks?

1. Click **Tangent Arc** .
2. Click. on the end point of a line, arc, ellipse, or spline.
3. Drag the arc to the desired shape and release. **SOLIDWORKS** infers from the pointer motion whether you want a tangent or normal arc.
4. Click .

Similarly, how do you create a tangent in SolidWorks 2013? Views “ to set the display for an individual view in a drawing, right-click the view in either the graphics area or the FeatureManager design tree and select **Tangent** Edge, then choose a tangent edge display mode. If you’re going to be making a lot of changes, it may be convenient to enable the **Line** Format toolbar by clicking on View > Toolbars > Line Format. You’ll not only have access to the tools mentioned above but layers as well.

How do I show edges in SolidWorks?

1. Click Hide/Show Edges.
2. Select the edges to hide (you can select edges individually, or use box selection), then click .
3. To show edges, click Hide/Show Edges.
4. Select the hidden edges highlighted in orange, (you can select edges individually, or use box selection), then click .

How do you draw a tangent arc in Solidworks?

1. Click Tangent Arc .
2. Click. on the end point of a line, arc, ellipse, or spline.
3. Drag the arc to the desired shape and release. SOLIDWORKS infers from the pointer motion whether you want a tangent or normal arc.
4. Click .

To align and group parallel dimensions: In a drawing, hold Ctrl and select two or more dimensions that you want to align. You can also select the group of dimensions by holding the left mouse button and dragging a box around the dimensions. on the Align toolbar, or click Tools > Dimensions > Align Parallel/Concentric .

How do you draw a curved circle in SolidWorks?

How do you make a surface plane in SolidWorks?

1. Create a non-intersecting, single contour, closed sketch.
2. Click Planar Surface (Surfaces toolbar) or Insert > Surface > Planar.
3. In the PropertyManager, select the sketch in the graphics area or FeatureManager design tree for Bounding Entities. .
4. Click OK .

How do you coincide two points in SolidWorks?

1. Select a line, point, center line or temporary axis with the left mouse button.
2. Hold the "Control" key and select the second line, point or temporary axis by left-clicking it.
3. Click the "Coincident" button in the Add Relations section of the properties box.

How do you make a plane in SolidWorks?

1. Click Plane (Reference Geometry toolbar) or Insert > Reference Geometry > Plane .
2. In the PropertyManager, select an entity for First Reference .
3. Select a Second Reference and Third Reference as necessary to define the plane.
4. Click .

How do I change the line format in Solidworks?

1. Select the edge or sketch entity you want to change. To select more than one entity at a time, hold Ctrl as you select.
2. Click a tool on the Line Format toolbar and select a format from the menu. The new format is applied to the selected entities.

How do I edit lines in Solidworks?

1. Select the section line or section view. The Section View PropertyManager appears.
2. Make any changes in the PropertyManager or in the graphics area and click . If you edit the section line in the graphics area, you may have to click Rebuild.

How do I change a construction line in Solidworks?

Click Tools > Sketch Tools > Construction Geometry. Select the For construction check box in the PropertyManager. Right-click any selected sketch entity and select Construction Geometry.

How do you show sketch lines in Solidworks drawing?

To show a sketch in a drawing: Right-click the sketch in the FeatureManager design tree and select Show. The sketch entities highlight in the graphics area when you point over the sketch name in the FeatureManager design tree. (Annotation toolbar), or click Insert > Model Items.

How do you create a hidden line in Solidworks?

Right-click the drawing view and select Properties. Select the Show Hidden Edges tab. Select a feature or component from either the drawing view or the FeatureManager design tree to add it to the list of items to be shown with hidden lines.
