1. Understand how people learn. Learning styles may be either visual, auditory, kinesthetic, or cognitive.
2. Tell stories.
3. Use props.
4. Let them teach you.
5. Get physical.
6. Play games.
7. Organize creatively.

8. Provide download time.

How do you do interactive virtual meetings?

1. More immersive video meeting experiences.
2. Tools that help reduce disruption.
3. Implement company branding and presence on the screen.
4. Boost engagement between audience and speaker.
5. Make content video-ready.

1. Pop Quiz. A simple quiz that asks some easy questions is a great way to start.
2. Play Games. You can also create a few fun training games for work that will get everyone involved in the learning process.
3. Tell Stories.

How do you make training not boring?

1. Incentives.
2. Stories. Crafting an exciting story to aid the delivery of less exciting content can be a great way to keeping delegates engaged, helps provide context to the learning and is effective at reinforcing key points.

How can I make my staff meeting more interactive?

1. Start with Good News. Think of this as a non-cheesy icebreaker.
2. Rotate Facilitators. Often, your weekly staff meeting will follow the same agenda week after week – this isn't a bad thing.
3. Challenge Yourself to Solve Problems.
4. Stay Focused.
5. Make It Fun.

2. Choose an angle that everyone can relate to.
3. Connect the topic to today's headlines.
4. Find a way to make the reader participate.
5. Make the topic more visual.

How do you make training scalable?

1. Define the scope of your program.
2. Invest in online resources.
3. Commit to a pilot program.
4. Establish a brand.
5. Use technology in your program.
6. Use microlearning in your program.

How do you make a meeting fun and engaging?

1. Fun ice-breaker activity, question or topic of conversation (non-work related)
2. Presentation on topic of the meeting.
3. Brainstorming in small groups on meeting topic.
4. Sharing brainstormed ideas with entire group for discussion.
5. Meeting recap and Q&A opportunity.

How do you increase engagement on zoom meetings?

Getting a team together virtually and keeping them engaged takes effort and planning. Stay on task and make Zoom meetings productive by planning an agenda ahead of time. It's important you also share this agenda with your team so they can be prepared for the meeting with resources, insights, and thoughtful questions.
