Introduction

Select the Join tool (), which you find on the default toolbar or by selecting Tools > Join. Click an edge in each piece with the Join tool cursor. A blue outline flashes as you click, and the shape begins to inherit the fill color of the first shape that you click.

As many you asked, how do you blend **shapes** in **SketchUp**?

Best answer for this question, how do you group things in **SketchUp**?

- 1. With the Select tool (), select all the entities you want to include in your group.
- 2. Select Edit > Group from the menu bar. Or context-click the selection and choose Group from the menu that appears. Everything in the selection becomes grouped within a bounding box.

Moreover, what does Weld edges do in SketchUp? Weld Edges in SketchUp Now, we've added 'Weld Edges' to SketchUp's native tools. This means you can join edges and arcs into a single polyline without installing an extension. If you haven't used a weld extension, we recommend starting to weld edges for any face where you'd like a smooth push/pull extrusion.Context-click the cutting shape, and choose Intersect Faces > With Model from the menu that appears. The command tells **SketchUp** to create edges where the **two** shapes intersect. With the Eraser tool (), erase or move the geometry that you don't want to keep.

How do I merge two groups in SketchUp?

- 1. Select the 2 groups [Note that you use Select+Ctrl to add to a Selection if they are difficult to select together] Then right-click context-menu â€~Group'.
- 2. If pre-Exploding the 2 Groups won't clash with other geometry Select the 2 groups and Explode.
- 3. Select one group and Edit it.

What is difference between group and component in SketchUp?

By definition, a Group is a single instance of a collection of geometry. A Component is a named collection of geometry that can exist at multiple locations within the model. Each instance is a repetition of all others. A change to one instance changes all other instances.

How do you add objects to a group?

- 1. Click (regular left-click) the group of 3.
- 2. Hold the shift key down while clicking the 4th object. By holding shift down you're telling the computer you want all objects to be active (or selected).
- 3. Release the mouse, and on the keyboard press Ctrl+G.

What is explode in SketchUp?

The explode feature breaks an entity into its segments, so that you can select one segment separately from the others. To explode an entity, select it, context-click the selection, and choose Explode Curve from the menu that appears.

How do you make something hollow in SketchUp?

Erase the interior to make your design hollow inside: Click on the black "selection†arrow at the far upper right corner of the menu. Then right click the interior of the circle. Click "Erase.â€
 You should remain with a hollow "o†or "donut-style†shape.

How do you make a non solid solid in SketchUp?

In order for SketchUp of any version to consider something a solid, it must be a group or component. The group or component must contain only geometry–no other groups or components–and every edge in the group or component must be shared by exactly two faces.

What is plug weld joint?

Plug welds are a round weld that is made inside of an existing hole most commonly in one piece of metal, welding that piece to another member. The plug weld symbol is a rectangle with a diameter symbol placed to the left of the symbol as well as the number associated with that diameter.

What is Intersect selection in SketchUp?

It takes faces you've selected and creates edges wherever they intersect. Perhaps you want to make a model that's a cube with a cylinder-shaped chunk taken out of it.

How does intersect faces work in SketchUp?

- Just select one of the objects, move it by pressing the quick-key "m†and place it on the other as you require.
- Select both objects, right click and select the "Intersect Faces†tab. Here you have two
 options.
- 3. And there you have it. We have successfully mated a sphere with a cube.

How do I create a dynamic component in SketchUp?

- 1. Select the component you want to make dynamic.
- 2. On the Dynamic Components toolbar, click the Component Attributes tool () or select Window > Component Attributes.
- 3. Click the Add Attribute plus sign icon to see a list of options.

How do I edit a group component in SketchUp?

What is grouping and ungrouping of objects?

Grouping and ungrouping objects. you can combine several objects into a group to treat them as a single one. when you ungrouped the other groups, objects in a nested group will remain grouped.

What do you understand by object Group and combining?

Grouped objects can be moved or transformed together. In this example, the ball and the boxes are grouped and resized as a group. Combining objects lets you group them permanently. You can combine multiple objects into one object, or combine objects with the background.

What are the advantages of grouping multiple shapes?

It is more advantageous while grouping. Grouping enhances faster and easier way of moving objects than moving one by one. The alignment of the object will not change when you move the objects.
