•“ How can I convert JPEG to STL file? First, you need to add a file for conversion: drag & drop your JPEG file or click inside the white area for choose a file. Then click the “Convert” button. When JPEG to STL conversion is completed, you can download your result file.

Can Tinkercad use SVG files?

Tinkercad does not support SVG import of image data, clipping paths, or fill data within the SVG. However, SVGs with fill color inside SVGs paths will be imported into Tinkercad. Also, the SVG must be under 4mb, as anything larger may be too complex to convert into 3D in one go.

What does STL file stand for?

The name STL is an acronym that stands for stereolithography “ a popular 3D printing technology. You might also hear it referred to as Standard Triangle Language or Standard Tessellation Language. Each file is made up of a series of linked triangles that describe the surface geometry of a 3D model or object.

Do you have multiple designs that you want to combine together? Just open them up in different tabs, select one of the models and use the copy command. Next, click over to the model in your other tab and use the paste command. Now all your designs can play together!

What files can I upload to Tinkercad?

You may import 3D files in STL or OBJ format into Tinkercad. You may also import 2D SVGs in vector format as extruded shapes into the Tinkercad app.

When you click “Export”, you have several options for the format in which you will export your design. What are the file types that can be exported from Tinkercad? Tinkercad export options include: STL, OBJ, GLTF, USDZ (iPad app only), and SVG.
