



How to remove a split line in solidworks?

As many you asked, how do I get rid of lines on surfaces in **SolidWorks**?

Also, what is a split **line** in **SolidWorks**? The Split Line. tool projects an entity (sketch, solid, surface, face, plane, or surface spline) to surfaces, or curved or planar faces. It divides a selected face into multiple separate faces. You can **split** curves on multiple bodies with one command.

2. On the menu, choose Draw > Construction Line > Erase.
3. On the Construction **Line** toolbar, click the Erase tool.
4. Type cline, choose Erase, and then press Enter.
5. â€¢
6. On the menu, choose Draw > Construction **Line** > Clear.
7. On the Construction Line toolbar, click the Clear tool.

How do I delete part of a line in Solid Edge?

How do you fill gaps in SolidWorks?

To create a filled surface, click Filled Surface on the Surfaces toolbar, or click Insert > Surface > Fill, set the PropertyManager options, and click OK .

How do I edit a mesh in SolidWorks?

1. Do one of the following: Click Mesh Edit. scanTo3D toolbar). Click Tools > ScanTo3D > Mesh Edit.
2. In the PropertyManager: Select a Manipulation Method. Set the options. For the Translate and Rotate options, you can set values manually or use the triad to set them.
3. Click .

How do you edit a mesh body in SolidWorks?

1. Click Mesh Edit.
2. Click Tools > ScanTo3D > Mesh Edit.
3. Right-click the mesh feature in the FeatureManager design tree and select Mesh Edit.

How do you delete a fillet in SolidWorks?

Hover over another fillet in the FeatureManager design tree that is applied to multiple edges. You want to remove the fillet from the circular edge only. Select the circular filleted edge. Click Remove.

How do you hide a construction line in SolidWorks?

1. Click Hide/Show Edges.
2. Select the edges to hide (you can select edges individually, or use box selection), then click .
3. To show edges, click Hide/Show Edges.
4. Select the hidden edges highlighted in orange, (you can select edges individually, or use box selection), then click .

How do you fix a small gap in SolidWorks?

1. Draw a sketch to encompass the defect.
2. Use a split curve to divide the model faces along the sketch from step 1.
3. Delete the problem model faces.
4. â€œCloseâ€ the open edge of the model.
5. Make use of a tool like Boundary, Loft, or Fill to â€œrebuildâ€ the missing faces.

How do you use the split line tool?

What do you mean by split line?

It means that your line is a String of numbers separated by commas. eg: "12.34,45.0,67.1" The line. `split("12.34,45.0,67.1")` returns an array of Strings.

How do you use the split feature in Solidworks?

1. Click Split (Features toolbar) or Insert > Features > Split.
2. In the PropertyManager, set the options.
3. Under Resulting Bodies, select the bodies to save under , or click Auto-assign Names.
4. Double-click the body name under File, type a name for the new part in the dialog box, then click Save.

How do you delete a line in CAD?

How do I remove unwanted lines in Sketchup?

Select the Eraser tool () or press the E key. Tap the Ctrl key (Microsoft Windows) or the Option key (macOS) to toggle Smooth Edges and then "erase" these lines the same way you would to delete them.

How do I remove a construction line in Sketchup?

How do I delete a line in word that won't delete?

1. Click directly above the line.
2. Go to the Home tab in the Ribbon.
3. Within the Paragraph section, click the dropdown arrow next to the Borders icon and select No Border.

How do I get rid of double lines in Word?

Click the line, connector, or shape that you want to delete, and then press Delete. Tip: If you want to delete multiple lines or connectors, select the first line, press and hold Ctrl while you select the other lines, and then press Delete.
