7. Place it on a surface.

1. Download the V-Ray for SketchUp installer, available [here](#).
2. Locate the installer and double-click to launch, EXE.
3. Please review the license agreement and click Next for your installation options.
4. Youâ€™re prompted for the version of SketchUp youâ€™re using, choose â€œSketchUp 2021â€
• and click Install.

How do I get high quality V-Ray renders?

In V-Ray for Sketchup, Rhino and Revit, render quality can be improved by dragging the Quality slider to a higher quality preset. and in this case slower render times are expected.

Why my V-Ray render is blurry?

The blurriness is due to texture resizing (downscale) by the GPU engine which is ON by default. You have to either turn it off or increase the texture size to a point where you are OK with the quality.

How do I add materials to Sketchup VRay?

To add a new material to your VRay, go to the Materials Tab in your VRay Settings window. At the bottom left (Below the materials list) youâ€™ll find an icon to add new materials. Select Generic. Rename your materials with a # to keep them at the top of your list.

1. Purchase rectified tiles.
2. Lay out the tiles directly onto the area where you will install them.
3. Mark any tiles to be cut with a pencil and straightedge.
4. Take the tiles up in the opposite order you set them down.
5. Press the tiles into the mortar in the same order you laid them out.

What is VRAY mesh Clipper?

V-Ray Clipper is a geometric primitive that can be used to clip away parts of the scene, as well as subtracts or intersects objects with each other. It is a render-time effect and does not modify the actual scene geometry in any way.

Hi, Yes clipping planes are not supported from V-Ray.
