- 1. In the drawing area, select a group.
- 2. Click Home tab Groups panel Ungroup. Find.

People ask also, what is the explode command in AutoCAD? Breaks a compound object into its component objects. Explodes a compound object when you want to modify its components separately. Objects that can be exploded include blocks, polylines, and regions, among others. The color, linetype, and lineweight of any exploded object might change.

Also the question is, what is the difference between burst and **explode** in AutoCAD? BURST is best used any time you need to explode a block or object but would like to preserve the Attribute values of the block instead of reverting them back to the default value. If you were to use the **EXPLODE** command, the block layers are also preserved when using the BURST command. There is no "unexplodeâ€: you can use BLOCK command or BEDIT command to make a new block. Hi, the command you are looking for is "joinâ€, it will connect all the lines you select. To execute this

command you need to turn all the lines you want to join into polylines if they aren't already.

How do I Unjoin a line in AutoCAD?

Click Modify tab Geometry panel Join drop-down (Unjoin Geometry). Select the geometry to unjoin.

When I explode a block in AutoCAD it disappears?

The issue is caused by Blocks that have a line type called Multiline in the blocks. If encountered the symptom is that you explode Blocks, and if you select Delete Blocks after exploding checked on, that the blocks disappear yet no linework at all is created.

How do you explode a block without losing attributes?

How do you ungroup the grouped objects?

Select a grouped object. Select Shape Format > Group > Ungroup.

Breaks a compound object into its component objects. Explodes a compound object when you want to modify its components separately. Objects that can be exploded include blocks, polylines, and regions, among others.

What is offset command in AutoCAD?

The offset command in AutoCAD is used to create parallel lines, concentric circles, and parallel curves. We can offset any object through a point or at a specified distance. We can create as many parallel lines and curves with the help of the offset command.

How do I edit a block in AutoCAD without changing the original?

You can do the same with separate files and Xref-ing instead of Inserting Blocks, by replacing "Block†or "Block definition†above with "Xref†or "drawingâ€, and replacing "BEDIT or REFEDIT†with "REFEDIT or open and editâ€.

How do you separate blocks in AutoCAD?

Select the block that you wish to break up and then select the menu item Edit > Other > Break up block. The block is broken up into its elements and the objects can now be individually edited once more.

How do you explode a dynamic block in AutoCAD?

Solution: You can specify whether or not a Dynamic Block can be exploded in drawing. Open the block definition in the Block Editor and make sure nothing is selected. In the Properties palette, under Block, click Allow Exploding, and on the drop-down list, select Yes or No.

What is the opposite of Join in AutoCAD?

Use BREAK to create a gap in an object, resulting in two objects with a gap between them. BREAK is often used to create space for block or text.

How do I delete a hatch in AutoCAD?

- 1. Double-click the hatch pattern (not the hatch boundary).
- 2. The Hatch Editor will open. Click Pick Points.
- 3. Type S in the Command line and press Enter.
- 4. The cursor will turn into a pickbox. Select each of the internal areas where you want to remove the hatch.

How do you break a line at an intersection in AutoCAD?

On the ribbon: HOME > MODIFY > then hover over the icons until it reports BREAK AT POINT (select that) … type F (read the prompts) …, select the line to break and break it at the INTERSECTION you want. That should do it.

How do you explode blocks and keep attributes?

If you'd like to explode a block with attributes and have them retain the assigned attribute value, then you'II need to use the BURST command. Burst will explode the block back into individual objects and keep the attribute values! Give it a try â€" you're going to love it.

How do you explode a hatch?

- 1. Click Modify > Explode (or type Explode).
- 2. In the graphics area, select objects to explode and press Enter. The selected objects are exploded. You can edit the individual objects.

What is grouping and ungrouping?

Grouping is useful when you should rearrange or manage many components on the screen. Instead of having to drag multiple components, you can click once and select multiple items and move them at one time. Ungrouping is particularly important when editing imported images, such as maps.
