

# How to save sketchup file in lower version online?

## Introduction

1. Open the version of SketchUp that matches the version of the **SketchUp** file.
2. Open the SketchUp file by clicking File > Open.
3. Click **File** > Save As. â€
4. Click the Save as Type drop-down menu and choose the version of SketchUp you would like use to open the **file**.

You asked, how do I save SketchUp files in **lower** version automatically? You can always map the default shortcut (Ctrl+S) to File > Save asâ€ and when you hit the button, the dialog pops up and you are then reminded to **save** in a previous **version**.

As many you asked, how do you convert a SKP 2018 to 2017?

1. first go to 3d warehouse (<https://3dwarehouse.sketchup.com/?hl=en> )
2. Create your account.
3. upload the **file** you want to convert (**Version-2018**)
4. Now refresh the page and go â€œmy 3d warehouseâ€ by clicking on your profile.
5. find the file you uploaded previously and open it.

Also know, how do I reduce a **SketchUp** file? You can also reduce SKP file size within the Sketchup Web App. With the app open, click on the â€œcomponentsâ€ icon in the right-hand toolbar to open the â€œcomponentsâ€ tab. There is a button at the top of the tab with a recycling icon on it. Click on this button to purge any unused components in your model.

Furthermore, how do you **save** a SketchUp **file online**?

1. After creating a new model, click either the "Untitled"™ file name or the "Save"™ command in the upper left of your screen.
2. In the Trimble Connect dialog, first, choose a Project to save your model in.
3. When you've picked a location in Trimble Connect, click the **Save Here** button.

SKP is the proprietary file type for **SketchUp** design software. This easily accessible program allows designers to put together advanced 3D models such as architectural graphics. Video games and furniture designs are among the other things you can create.

## How do I convert SKP to 3DS?

1. Select File > Export > 3D Model.
2. Navigate to the location where you want to save your file.
3. From the Export Type drop-down list, select 3DS File (\*.
4. (Optional) By default, the 3DS file has the same name as your SketchUp model.

## How do I open SKP files in SketchUp online?

1. Select File > Open.
2. In the Open dialog box that appears, as shown in the following figure, navigate to the location where the .skp file is saved on your hard drive.
3. Select the file and click the Open button. The model appears in the viewer.

## Is Google SketchUp free?

SketchUp Free is a truly free product for personal projects (non-commercial applications). It works in any modern web browser (so not IE), so you can now use SketchUp on Mac, Windows, Linux, and even Chromebooks!

## How big are SketchUp files?

SU on a reasonably powerful machine can cope with files up to around 100Mb, and millions of edges and faces. Your file size is a bit bigger than that, and into the size where SU starts to struggle unless you are carfeul.

## How do I reduce poly count in SketchUp?

Click on the icon. A box will appear with the option to select the percent reduction. This will control the percent of faces that the object is reduced by. If you are placing the object somewhere in the midground you may choose a percentage between 40-60%.

## Where does SketchUp Web save files?

skp files stored on your device's local storage and supported cloud storage services from within the SketchUp Viewer app. On the Home Screen, tap the Cloud icon ( ) and select Files on Device to browse the device's Storage Access Framework.

## How do I save a SketchUp model to Google Drive?

1. After you begin creating your new model, click Untitled or Save in the upper left.
2. On the Google Drive panel that appears, type a name for your model, as shown in the figure, and click OK.
3. Using Google's picker, select a folder where you want to save the model on your Google Drive.

## Can you export from SketchUp free?

If you made your model in SketchUp Free, you can only export the model as an STL file. Once you do this, you can upload to Sketchfab.

## Can I open SKP file online?

You can open . SKP files from anywhere " wherever you are. Present conversational details of your models when you show scenes, layers and views " right on your mobile device.

## Which software can open SKP files?

1. Trimble SketchUp Viewer.
2. Web. Trimble 3D Warehouse.
3. iOS. Trimble SketchUp Viewer.

## How do I save a SketchUp model as a 3D PDF?

1. Right click on the 3D layer thumbnail.
2. Select Export 3D layer.
3. Name the file and select U3D from the Format dropdown menu.
4. Click the Save button.
5. The 3D Export Options dialogue box will open.
6. Make sure that JPEG is selected from the Texture Format dropdown.
7. Use ECMA1 for the U3D Options.

## Can 3DS Max Open SketchUp files?

Solution: Yes, native SketchUp files (SKP) can be brought into 3ds Max for editing and rendering starting in 3ds Max 2019.3 and more recent versions using the Import feature. To Import an SKP file, see the 3ds Max Help Documentation: SketchUp (SKP) Files.

## What is a max file?

. max files usually contain three-dimensional (3D) scenes and images. They are primarily used to create video games, animations, and 3D pictures. They usually come from the Autodesk 3DS Max graphics program, but there are other applications that save in their format. You can recover lost .

Anybody can get a free 30-day trial of SketchUp Studio without commitment from the SketchUp website.

## Who invented SketchUp?

SketchUp was developed by startup company @Last Software of Boulder, Colorado, co-founded in 1999 by Brad Schell and Joe Esch. SketchUp was created in August 2000 as a 3D content creation tool and was envisioned as a software program for design professionals.

## Is 16gb RAM enough for SketchUp?

If youâ€™re using SketchUp for professional work, get at least 32GB. You probably wonâ€™t need more than that â€” and you could scrape by with less if your budget is tight â€” but 32GB is a great sweet spot.

## Does SketchUp need graphics card?

SketchUp only receives a minor boost to the performance by the Graphics Card. Therefore we recommend that only a low-end NVIDIA GeForce graphics card is required for 3D modelling within

SketchUp.
