#### How do I size a keyframe in Cinema 4D?

- 1. STEP 1: SELECT THE OBJECT YOU WANT TO KEYFRAME IN THE OBJECT MANAGER.
- 2. STEP 2: GO TO THE FRAME IN THE TIMELINE RULER WHERE YOU WANT TO INSERT THE KEYFRAME.

- 3. STEP 3: PUSH THE SET KEY BUTTON IN THE ANIMATION PALETTE.
- 4. STEP 4: RINSE AND REPEAT.

# How can you retain the proportions while resizing an object?

Dragging while maintaining the proportions and keeping the center in the same place: Hold down CTRL+SHIFT.

## What is proportional scale?

a scale on which are marked parts proportional to the logarithms of the natural numbers; a logarithmic scale.

# How do you reduce an object proportionally?

Holding down Shift + Alt (Windows) or Shift + Option (Mac) while clicking and dragging a handle will resize an object proportionally from its center if you click a corner handle, or will adjust opposite sides equally if you are using a side handle.

# How do you keyframe?

- 1. Click the Stopwatch icon next to the property name to activate it. After Effects creates a keyframe at the current time for that property value.
- 2. Choose Animation > Add [x] Keyframe, where [x] is the name of the property you are animating.

# How do I resize something without distorting it?

- 1. To maintain proportions, press and hold SHIFT while you drag the corner sizing handle.
- 2. To keep the center in the same place, press and hold CTRL while you drag the sizing handle.

# What must you do to proportionally scale a graphic?

Hold the Shift ⇧ key while resizing to scale the object only horizontally or vertically. Hold both the Shift ⇧ and Option ⌥ keys while resizing to scale the object proportionally from the center of its bounding box. Tip: Use the S keyboard shortcut to quickly select the Scale tool.

## How do you keep the same ratio?

To find an equal ratio, you can either multiply or divide each term in the ratio by the same number (but not zero). For example, if we divide both terms in the ratio 3:6 by the number three, then we get the equal ratio, 1:2.

# How do you scale a photo proportionally?

If the Shift key is held down whilst moving the handle, then the proportions of the object will be preserved. For example, if I hold Shift and drag the bottom edge upwards to reduce the size by half, then the right edge will automatically move to the left to reduce the width of the object by the same amount.

- var ratio = image. Height / image. Width;
- var width = image. Height / ratio;
- 3. var height = image. Width \* ratio;

# How can you scale an object uniformly without changing its proportion?

By holding the shift key as you drag, the object will hold its proportions as it scales up and down in the direction you pull it. Alternately, by holding both shift and the alt key together while you drag, the object will proportionally scale in all directions, regardless of which direction you drag.

#### What is the use of resize option?

The act of changing the dimensions of an object in a graphical environment. For example, in a graphical user interface, a user may resize their window to allow them to view other windows on their screen, or help arrange windows. To resize a window, move the cursor to the edge or corner of the window.
