How to select all detail lines in revit?

Description

Press Tab to highlight connected elements, and then click to select. See Selecting Chains of Walls and **Lines**. Use the **Select** All Instances tool to select all instances of an element or family type in your project or view.

Also, how do you **select all** details in a view in Revit?

You asked, how do you delete **all** detail lines in **Revit**? Click Manage tab Settings panel Additional Settings drop-down Line Patterns. In the Line Patterns dialog, select the line pattern. Click Delete. When prompted to confirm the deletion, click Yes.

Furthermore, how do you use **detail lines** in Revit? The Detail Line tool has the same line styles as the Line tool, but detail lines are view-specific, like detail components and other annotations. Detail lines are drawn in the view's sketch plane. In MEP views, detail lines are sketched as full-toned lines. Click Annotate tab **Detail** panel (**Detail** Line).

People ask also, how do I select a model line in **Revit**?

- 1. Click (Model Line).
- 2. Click Modify | Place **Lines** tab Draw panel, and **select** a sketching option or Pick **Lines** to create lines by selecting lines or walls within the model.
- 1. While pressing Ctrl, click each of the elements.
- 2. Draw a selection box by placing the cursor on one side of the elements to be selected and dragging it diagonally to form a rectangular boundary.
- 3. Press Tab to highlight connected elements, and then click to select.

How do you select all beams in Revit?

To select any elements that are wholly or partially within the boundary of the box, drag the cursor from right to left. Click Modify | Multi-Select tab Filter panel (Filter). The Filter dialog lists all categories of the elements that are currently selected.

How do you filter a detail line in Revit?

- 1. Filter. Select a whole bunch of elements and go to the Selection Filter.
- 2. View Visibility.
- 3. Select All Instances in View.
- 4. Isolate.
- 5. Properties.

- 6. Tooltip.
- 7. Worksets.
- 8. Workset Visibility.

How do you select pinned elements in Revit?

Simply toggle the "Select Pinned Element†button at the bottom right corner of your Revit model to disable, and your pinned element will no longer be selectable. Toggle it back on when you need to make adjustments to the pinned element. Pinned objects will show a thumbtack when selected.

How do you purge unused line styles in Revit?

- 1. Click Manage tab Settings panel Additional Settings drop-down Line Styles.
- 2. In the Line Styles dialog, select the line style name.
- 3. Click Delete.
- 4. When prompted to confirm the deletion, click Yes.

Can you convert detail lines to model lines in Revit?

The Detail Line tool creates detail lines for detailing drawings. Detail lines are visible only in the view in which they are drawn. Often they are drawn over the model view. You can convert detail lines to model lines.

What is the difference between model line and detail line?

Because they exist in 3D space, you can use model lines to represent geometry such as cords or cables supporting a tarp. In contrast to model lines, detail lines exist only in the view they are drawn in (see Draw Detail Lines). You can convert model lines to detail lines, and vice-versa. See Converting Line Types.

Where is reference line in Revit?

In the Family Editor, click Create tab Datum panel (Reference Line). Using the drawing tools, sketch the line. The line displays as a solitary solid line until selected or when highlighted during preselection.

How do you join lines in Revit?

- 1. Click Home tab Modify panel Edit Polyline. Find.
- 2. Select a polyline, spline, line, or arc to edit.
- 3. Enter j (Join).
- 4. Select one or more polylines, splines, lines, or arcs that are located end to end.
- 5. Press Enter to end the command.

How do you select multiple lines at once?

- 1. Select the first item that you want. For example, select some text.
- 2. Press and hold CTRL.
- 3. Select the next item that you want. Important Be sure to press and hold CTRL while you select the next item that you want to include in the selection.

How do you select multiple lines in CAD?

Multiple objects can still be selected with selection or crossing windows, and by holding the Shift key while clicking items.

How do I move multiple elements in Revit?

Move Elements by Dragging You can click and drag a selected element to a new location in the drawing area. If multiple elements are selected, they all move when you drag one.

What is view filter in Revit?

There are two types of Revit View Filters that we can utilize in Revit. "Rule-based†filters identify elements using parameter values for selected categories. For example, you can create a rule-based filter that identifies all walls that have a Fire Rating parameter of 2 hours.

Where is the filter button in Revit?

Click View tab Graphics panel (Visibility/Graphics), and click the Filters tab. Click Add. The Add Filters dialog lists existing filters. If the desired filter does not exist, click Edit/New to create a rule-based filter.

How do I convert lines to a wall in Revit?

- 1. Right-click a wall tool, and click Apply Tool Properties to Linework.
- 2. Select the line to convert, and press Enter.
- 3. When prompted to erase the original geometry, press Enter to retain the linework, or enter y (Yes) to erase it.
- 4. Edit the properties of the new walls in the Properties palette, if necessary.

What does it mean to compact a central model?

Compact Central Model This option reduces file size when saving workset-enabled files. The process of compacting rewrites the entire file and removes obsolete parts in order to save space.
