- 1. In the Windows control panel, double-click the **Mouse** icon to open the Mouse Properties dialog window.
- 2. Click the Buttons tab.
- 3. In the Wheel button drop-down list, select AutoScroll.
- 4. Click OK.

Correspondingly, how do I make my mouse **pan** in AutoCAD 2021? Position the cursor at the start location and press the left mouse button down. Drag the cursor to the new location. You can also press the mouse scroll **wheel** or middle button down and drag the cursor to **pan**.

Additionally, how do I change the pan settings in AutoCAD? Change the setting in **AutoCAD**: Type "MBUTTONPAN†in the command and press Enter.†Then give the system variable is **set** to 1.

You asked, how do you pan using a mouse?

1. Click Raster menu Options. The Raster Design Options dialog box is displayed.

- 2. Click the User Preferences tab.
- 3. Under Mouse Settings, select Shift + Left Click Image Select if you want to select an image by pressing shift and clicking your left mouse button.
- 4. Click OK to exit the dialog box.

How do I use the pan on my TouchPad?

- 1. First, you must configure your TouchPad to produce middle clicks.
- 2. The pointer will turn into an icon which looks something like this: .
- 3. Once you have reached the desired speed, lift your finger and watch the contents of the window continue to pan!

How do I fix my cursor in AutoCAD?

- 1. Click anywhere on the ribbon.
- 2. Move the mouse cursor over the Viewport Controls in the upper-left corner of the drawing window. Move the model.
 Change the visual style.
 Switch between model and layout tabs.

- 7. Exit and relaunch AutoCAD.

How do I change my mouse wheel zoom?

How do you pan left and right with a mouse?

- 1. Ctrl-Up arrow: Pan down.
- 2. Ctrl-Down arrow: Pan up.
- 3. Ctrl-Right arrow: Pan left.
- 4. Ctrl-Left arrow: Pan right.

How do you access the pan tool of AutoCAD?

* Right click and select PAN from contextual menu PAN command Press and hold middle mouse button O All of the above Øa

What is the command of pan?

Pan: Hold down the mouse wheel as you move the mouse around your drawing. Zoom in: Roll the mouse wheel forward (i.e., toward your computer). Zoom out: Roll the mouse wheel backward (i.e., toward you).

How do I make my cursor snap to grid in AutoCAD?

- 1. On the Status Bar, right-click on snap mode Find and select Snap Settings.
- 2. In the Drafting Settings dialog box, Snap and Grid tab, click Snap On.
- 3. Under Snap Type, make sure Grid Snap and Rectangular Snap are selected.

Why does my mouse wheel zoom instead of scroll?

One of the most common causes that will trigger this kind of behavior is a stuck CTRL-key. If you didn't know, if you press any of the CTRL keys and scroll upwards or downwards, the mouse's scroll will produce zooming.

Why does my scroll wheel go up and down?

This is because mouse scroll wheel jumps up and down sometimes if the wheel speed is set up too high.

How do I get my mouse to scroll sideways?

- 1. Press and hold SHIFT.
- 2. Scroll up or down using your mouse wheel (or another vertical scrolling function of your mouse).
