1. Go to **sketchup**.google.com to download either the free or pro version of SketchUp.
2. Open SketchUp and make sure the standard views are on your toolbar.
3. Click on the icon in the standard view toolbar that shows the roof of the house.
4. Begin drawing your 2D element.

1. Select the Zoom tool or press the Z key. You can also select Camera > Field of View from the menu bar.
 2. Type a value in degrees or millimeters, respectively. For example, typing 45 deg sets a 45 degree field of view; typing 35 mm sets a focal length equivalent to a 35mm camera.
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1. Click Modify tab Design panel Convert 3D To 2D Polylines Find.
 2. Select the polyline(s) to convert. Press Enter.

Select the SketchUp model entity, context-click the selection, and choose Edit 3D View from the menu that appears. Or, you can enter Edit 3D View by double-clicking, or selecting the model entity and pressing Enter.

How do you make a 2D elevation in SketchUp?

1. Camera > Parallel Projection. To change the view from a perspective to a 2D view, go to **Camera** and select **parallel projection** from the dropdown menu.
2. Camera > Standard Views > Front.
3. Default Tray > Styles > Edit.
4. Edge Settings.
5. Face Settings.
6. Modeling Settings.
7. Shadows.
8. View > Fog.

How do you convert 3D polyline to 2D?

1. Click Modify tab Design panel Convert 3D To 2D Polylines Find.
2. Select the polyline(s) to convert. Press Enter.

How do I switch back to 2D in AutoCAD?

To Switch between the 3D and 2D graphics display, click View menu > Visual Styles > 2D Wireframe or 3D Wireframe. This controls background color, grid style, and UCS icon style among other things.

How do I flatten a 3D drawing into 2D CAD?

1. Turn off or freeze any hatch layers with hatch patterns so they are not included in the selection.
2. Type FLATTEN at the command line.
3. Select all objects and press the Enter key.
4. Type N for No when prompted to remove hidden lines.

What is 2D floor plan?

A 2D floor plan is a type of diagram that shows the layout of a property or space from above. It will often show the walls and room layout, plus fixed installations like windows, doors, and stairs as well as furniture. 2D means the floor plan is a “flat” drawing, without perspective or depth.

SketchUp is a widely used piece of software in the interior design and architecture community and is great for bringing architectural or design plans to life. The software helps you take 2D drawings and turn these in to fully customised 3D models “ complete with furniture, accessories and custom joinery.

Can you change dimensions in SketchUp free?

and then change the dimensions using the box in the lower right hand corner. SketchUp doesn’t work that way. If you want to change the dimensions after you’ve created the rectangle, select an edge and use the Move tool to move the desired distance or use the Scale tool to resize it.

How do I see dimensions in SketchUp?

Click the Tape Measure icon (). At the prompt, move your cursor over the beginning point for your measurement and click. Move your cursor over the second point of your measurement and click. A measurement appears on your model, as shown in yellow in the following figure.

How do I use the Dimension tool in SketchUp?

1. Select the Dimension tool ().
2. Click the starting point of your dimension.
3. Move the cursor along the entity you want to dimension until the inference engine highlights your desired ending point.
4. Click the ending point of your dimension.
