



# How to turn off design options in revit?

## Description

In the Graphics panel, click Visibility/Graphics. In the Visibility/Graphic Overrides dialog box, click the **Design Options** tab. The dialog box will not have this tab if no design options exist in the project. In the Design Option column, select the design option override for each **design** option set.

Likewise, how do I get rid of design options in **Revit**?

1. Click Manage tab Design Options panel (**Design Options**).
2. If you are currently editing a design option, click Finish Editing.
3. In the **Design Options** dialog, select the design option set to delete.
4. Under Option Set, click Delete.
5. At the confirmation prompt, click Yes.

Subsequently, how do I get rid of design options? If you are currently editing a **design** option, click Finish Editing. In the Design Options dialog, select the design option set to delete. Under Option Set, click Delete.

Furthermore, how do you hide **options** in Revit?

Also the question is, how do I **turn** on design **options** in Revit?

1. Click File tab Options.
2. On the User Interface tab, select Enable **Design Options**.
3. Click OK.

In the Design **Options** dialog, select the design option set that includes the desired option. If the desired option is secondary, select the design option in the list, and click Make Primary to promote it to the primary option. Under Option Set, click Accept Primary to incorporate the primary option into the main model.

## Where are Revit design options?

On the Manage tab within Revit, select the Design Option button. Select the New button under Design Option Set to create a new option set called "Option Set 1". The first option will be automatically created and will be called "Option 1 (primary)".

## How do you accept primary design options in Revit?

To do this, navigate to the Design Options manager (Manage Tab > Design Options), and find the Option Set you've worked through. If the design you would like to keep is not the primary option, select it, and choose "Make Primary" on the right-hand side. Then, select the Option Set and click "Accept Primary".

## When working with design options what Cannot be placed in the Option Sets?

Annotations and details (such as keynotes, dimensions, and tags) are view-specific elements. They cannot be part of a design option. Deleting a design option or a design option set also removes the elements and views associated with the options.

## How do you turn on hidden elements in Revit?

Select the element. Do one of the following: Click Modify | tab Reveal Hidden Elements panel (Unhide Element) or (Unhide Category). Right-click the element, and click Unhide in View Elements or Category.

## Can you hide elements in Revit?

In the drawing area, select the element to hide. Click Modify | tab View panel Hide in View drop-down (Hide Elements), (Hide Category), or (Hide by Filter). Alternatively, right-click the element, and click Hide in View Elements, Category, or By Filter.

## How do you turn off layers in Revit?

1. Open a project view in Revit.
2. Click View tab Graphics panel (Visibility/Graphics).
3. Click the Imported Categories tab.
4. In the Visibility column, click to expand the DWG file name of the linked or imported file.
5. Clear the check boxes for any layers that you want to hide in the current view.
6. Click OK.

## What is design Option tool in Revit?

## **Where is Revit Options menu?**

The Options Bar is located below the ribbon. It displays conditional tools dependent on the current tool or selected element. To move the Options Bar to the bottom of the Revit window (above the status bar), right-click the Options Bar, and click Dock at bottom.

## **How do I use design options in Revit LT?**

To enable design options, change the setting on the User Interface tab of the Options dialog. If you use Revit LT to open a Revit project that includes design options, but design options are disabled in Revit LT: You can change view settings to see the different design options that are available.

## **How do you move something from design option to main model in Revit?**

Revit Architecture moves the selected elements to the active option. To finish editing the active option, click Manage tab Design Options panel, and select Main Model from the drop-down list.

## **What is design Option?**

A design option set is a collection of possible solutions for a particular design problem. Each design option set contains one primary option and one or more secondary options.

## **How do I show multiple design options in Revit?**

In order to study several design options, you must first create a design option set. Then, within that set, you can create multiple design options. One option in the set will be the primary option and the others will be secondary options. You can then create views to display and print the various options.

## **What does accept primary mean in Revit?**

Note: Accepting the primary option deletes all secondary options and the design option set. You can undo this action, but you should be sure that you do not need any other options.

## How do I move the host element to the design option?

1. Open a project view that shows the elements to be moved.
2. Click Manage tab Design Options panel, and select Main Model from the drop-down list.
3. Select the main model elements to move.
4. Click Manage tab Design Options panel (Add to Set).
5. In the Add to Design Option Set dialog, for Add selection to, select the desired set.

## Where is option bar in Revit?

The Options Bar is located below the ribbon. It displays conditional tools dependent on the current tool or selected element. To move the Options Bar to the bottom of the Revit window (above the status bar), right-click the Options Bar, and click Dock at bottom.

## How do I turn off temporary hide in Revit?

To exit temporary hide/isolate mode without saving changes: On the View Control Bar, click , and then click Reset Temporary Hide/Isolate. All temporarily hidden elements are restored to the view.

## How do you hide model groups in Revit?

1. In the drawing area, select a model group that has an attached detail group, or groups.
2. Click Modify | Model Groups tab Group panel (Attached Detail Groups).
3. In the Attached Detail Group Placement dialog, select or clear check boxes to show or hide the attached detail group.
4. Click OK.

## How do I permanently hide in Revit?

1. Temporary Hide-Isolate can be made permanently by checking by using Apply Hide-Isolate to View. So, create a duplicate of the View and then apply this option “ 1.
2. You can also Save your Selection , Edit it and then Load it when required “ 2.
