1. On the Sketch contextual tab, select Modify > Offset .
2. In the canvas, select the sketch curve, a chain of connected sketch curves, or a sketch profile to offset.
3. Specify the distance to offset.

Furthermore, how do you **offset** a shape in **Fusion** 360?

1. Use the SURFACE > CREATE > Offset function.
2. Disable the chain selection option.

You asked, where is **offset Fusion** 360? The offset command can be activated from the sketch dropdown list from the right-click sketch menu, by right-clicking to activate the marking menu, selecting sketch, and then the **offset** option located in the lower left or with the keyboard shortcut letter **O** as in Oscar.

Moreover, how do you **offset** faces in Fusion 360?

1. In the Design workspace, Solid tab, select Modify > **Offset** Face.
 2. Select a face you want to modify.
 3. Drag the manipulator or enter an exact value.
 4. Select OK.
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1. Click Sketch > Offset. The Type dialog box opens.
 2. Select an edge type.
 3. Select one or more appropriate entities or edges to offset.
 4. To offset the edge in the direction of the arrow, type a positive value.
 5. Press ENTER or click .

How do you use the loft in Fusion 360?

1. In the Design workspace, Form contextual environment, select Create > Loft .
2. In the canvas, select two or more Profiles to loft.
3. In the Loft dialog, select an end condition or continuity for the first and last profiles:

How do you cut a body in Fusion 360?

1. From the Solid menu select Modify > Split body.
2. Select Body to Split.
3. Select Body to use as the splitting tool.
4. Select OK to create the split.

How do you fillet in Fusion 360?

1. Click Design > Solid > Modify > Fillet .
2. In the dialog, from the Type dropdown list, select Rule Fillet.
3. Select a Rule to create fillets on all edges in a single selection set, or only at shared edges of two selection sets:
4. In the canvas, select faces or features to fillet.

How do I change the sketch plane in Fusion 360?

1. Right clicking the sketch icon in the timeline.
2. Click Redefine Sketch Plane.
3. Re-select the geometry reference to use as the new sketch plane.
4. Click OK.

1. Select the Offset tool () or press the F key.
2. Click one of your selected line segments or the face you want to offset.
3. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
4. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
5. Click to finish the offset.

What offset line?

Offset line means a supplementary traverse close to and approximately parallel with an irregular boundary line. An offset line provides data for computing areas and locates salient points on the irregular boundary line by measured distances referenced to the offset line.
