5. Adjust the Quantity, Distance, and Start Point settings.

In this regard, what is a **pattern** in Fusion 360? A sketch **pattern** creates rectangular or circular patterns of sketch geometry. The patterned geometry is fully constrained by default. Once you complete the sketch pattern, you can **use** it to create bodies or features on the model.

Amazingly, what are circular patterns? Use circular patterns to create multiple instances of one or more features that you can space uniformly around an axis. **Pattern** instances inherit the feature color of the original feature when the: Pattern is based on one feature.

Use thePathPattern command to create copies of specified entities along a path. It is the command window variant of the Pattern command, option Path.

There are a couple of ways to combine sketches in Fusion 360. The first is to copy and paste one sketch into another. Select the first sketch and Copy it to your clipboard. Next, edit your second sketch and select Paste.

Use Combine|Cut operation to create the hexagonal hole. Another, more parametric, method is to use or create a sketch on the face with the hole location, draw a hexagon at the hole location, then use Extrude|Cut operation.

What is path pattern?

Includes a chain of path elements for fast matching and accumulates computed state for quick comparison of patterns. PathPattern matches URL paths using the following rules: ? matches one character. * matches zero or more characters within a path segment.

How do you sweep in Fusion 360?

1. On the toolbar, click Solid > Create > Sweep .
2. In the dialog, on the Feature tab, select Single Path as the Type setting.
3. In the canvas, select a Profile to sweep along a path.
4. Select a Path to sweep the profile along.
