Introduction

1. Press Space Bar to choose the select tool.
2. Click on the right edge of the square.
3. Press M to choose the move tool.
4. Click once on your selected edge.
5. Press an arrow key to constrain your transformation to the proper axis.
6. Drag your mouse and you will skew the square.

1. With the Select tool (), select the geometry you want to scale.
2. Select the Scale tool () or press the S key.
3. Click an edge or face grip (not a corner grip).
4. Move the cursor to scale the entity.
5. Click to set your selection's new scale.

Choose Plugins > Chris Fullmer Tools > Shape Bender to activate the tool. Click once on the straight edge you drew in Step 3 (make sure it's highlighted before you click on it). Click once on the curve you created in Step 4. Wait for SketchUp to think.

How do I edit texture in SketchUp?

1. With the Select tool, click the face with the texture you want to edit.
2. Choose Edit†Face†Texture†Position.
3. Edit your texture.
4. Click anywhere outside your texture in your modeling window to exit Texture Edit mode.

How do you snap in SketchUp?

How do you make views in SketchUp?

1. Select Window > Scenes to open the Scenes window.
2. Select the Add Scene icon (). The scene appears in the Scenes window with the default name of Scene 1.
3. If you want to change the name of your scene or add a description, select the Show Details icon () in the upper right of the Scenes window.

How do I save an image as high quality in SketchUp?

Select File > Export > 2D Graphic. The Export 2D Graphic dialog box appears. Navigate to the location where you want to save your image. (Optional) In the File Name box, type a name for your image file.

How do you extrude a curve in SketchUp?

1. Identify the path for your extrusion.
2. Draw a face or profile that you want to follow the path.
3. Select the Follow Me tool ().
4. Click and drag the face that you created along the path.
5. Click to complete the Follow Me operation when you reach the end of the path.

How do you scale a dynamic component in SketchUp?

1. Context-click on the component.
2. Select the Dynamic Components > Component Attributes menu item.
3. Click the + button next to the component's name.
4. Click on the add attribute button in the last row of the attributes list.
5. Click on the Scale tool attribute in the list.

How do I create a dynamic component in SketchUp?

1. Select the component you want to make dynamic.
2. On the Dynamic Components toolbar, click the Component Attributes tool () or select Window > Component Attributes.
3. Click the Add Attribute plus sign icon to see a list of options.

How do you scale materials for free in SketchUp?

You can resize a texture by right clicking on the face to which it is applied and moving the Rotate pin in or out. It's exactly the same in regular SketchUp. I had been working not to scale so it was my fault, but glad to know how to scale the textures now!

How do you offset in SketchUp?

1. Select the Offset tool () or press the F key.
2. Click one of your selected line segments or the face you want to offset.
3. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
4. Move the cursor to define the offset dimension.
5. Click to finish the offset.

What does Weld edges do in SketchUp?

Now, we've added "Weld Edges" to SketchUp's native tools. This means you can join edges and arcs into a single polyline without installing an extension. If you haven't used a weld extension, we recommend starting to weld edges for any face where you'd like a smooth push/pull extrusion.
