You asked, how do you structure a **learning** experience? Every structured learning **experience** has three basic components: framing, activity, and closure (Figure 1) and each component has multiple parts each related to the purpose of each component.

Frequent question, how do you **write** a **learning** experience in a lesson plan?

1. Check students' prior knowledge, skill levels and potential misconceptions.
2. Identify a series of specific learning goals/intentions.
3. Organise and sequence the specific learning goals/intentions.
4. Use W.H.E.R.E.T.O to inform **learning** events/experiences.

## What are the three types of learning experience?

The three basic types of learning styles are visual, auditory, and kinesthetic. To learn, we depend on our senses to process the information around us. Most people tend to use one of their senses more than the others.

## What is a key learning experience?

A Key Learning Experience is an experience, event, or time in your life that had significant impact on you, making it particularly memorable (Peet, 2010, p 24, SCQF, 2010, p. 19) . A reason a particular experience feels significant could be because it: stimulated an "a-ha" moment of realization or insight.
