While the free version of 3D Slash beats Tinkercad because it's available through both a website and offline app, the only major limitation is that users are unable to save their designs on the program, which is only available on the paid Premium plan, though you can export your work to STL or OBJ.

2. Step 2: Head over to the circuits tab and click “Create new Circuit”

5. Step 5: Drag two LED bulbs, and a small breadboard.
