- 4. Click the value for Line Color to choose a line color.

What are detail lines in Revit?

The Detail Line tool has the same line styles as the Line tool, but detail lines are view-specific, like detail components and other annotations. Detail lines are drawn in the view's sketch plane. In MEP views, detail lines are sketched as full-toned lines.

How do you change area boundaries in Revit?

- 1. Click Architecture tab Room & Area panel drop-down (Area and Volume Computations).
- 2. On the Computations tab of the Area and Volume Computations dialog, for Room Area Computation, select one of the following options:

- 1. In the Create Property Line dialog, select Create by sketching.
- 2. Click (Pick Lines) or other sketch tools to sketch lines.
- 3. Sketch the property lines. Lines should form a closed loop.

How do I enable properties in Revit?

Go to the View tab of the ribbon, find the Windows panel to the far right, click the User Interface button, and uncheck or check the Properties option. This will also open or close the Properties palette.

Where is site settings in Revit?

Use the Site Settings dialog to view or change site settings. To change site settings properties, click Massing & Site tab Model Site panel . Displays contour lines. If you clear the check box, custom contour lines still display in the drawing area.

How do you plot coordinates in Revit?

Click on the Manage Tab > Coordinates > Specify Coordinates at a Point. Click on the model line at the known origin point. The Specify Shared Coordinate dialog will open. Enter the coordinate values, the correct datum (Elevation) and the angle to True North.

How do you make a wide line thicker in Revit?

1- ADJUST LINES THICKNESS ON THE "LINE WEIGHTS†MENU Click on "Additional Settings†in the Manage tab. Select Line Weights. This is where you will assign a thickness value to each number. In the Model Line category, you can assign a different thickness for different scales.
