It is one of the most widely used design and engineering programs and is used by many different professions and companies around the world because of its wide range of features and excellent functionality. Introduction

Discussion. To make copies, activate the Move tool and press the Ctrl key (Option on the Mac). SketchUp is very flexible in how you can set the spacing and number of copies: After the first copy is made, you can enter the number of copies you want and set the spacing between them.

Similarly, how do you paste multiple times in SketchUp? Choose Edit > Copy from the menu bar or use a keyboard shortcut (Ctrl+C for Windows, Command+C for macOS) to copy your selection. Select Edit > Paste from the menu bar or use a keyboard shortcut (Ctrl+V for Windows, Command+V for macOS) changing the cursor to the Move tool icon.

Also, how do you duplicate in SketchUp?

Also the question is, how do you **copy** an array in **SketchUp**? External Array. Open up SketchUp and select the item that you wish to copy. Click on the Move icon and start to move it. After you start to move it, press down on CTRL and move it to where you want the copy.

Frequent question, how do I **copy** a group in **SketchUp** file? Select the group and hit Ctrl+C to **copy** it. Go to the other **SketchUp** session and click on Edit>Paste in place. This should put a copy of the group in the same location relative to the model origin as it was in the original file. Copy and paste **multiple** items using the Office Clipboard Select the first item that you want to **copy**, and press CTRL+C. Continue copying items from the same or other files until you have collected all of the items that you want. The Office Clipboard can hold up to 24 items.

Can you push pull multiple surfaces in SketchUp?

If we want to extrude (push/pull) a lot of faces the same distance, we might use the default SketchUp Push Pull tool, but it might take very long if we have a lot of faces. By default, if we push one face and then double click on different one, the new one will be push/pulled the same distance.

How do you make multiple copies of furniture in SketchUp?

How do you select multiple objects in SketchUp?

1. To add to the current selection, hold down the Shift key and click additional elements.
2. To remove an element that's already in the selection set, hold down the Shift key and click the element you want to remove.

How do you repeat an action in SketchUp?

SketchUp does not have a command driven interface. Once a SketchUp tool is activated, it remains active until another tool is selected. This means a user can use the MoveTool successively on as many objects as they wish – no “repeat” necessary.

Which Array command can be used to draw multiple objects? You can use the “AR” command to make multiple copies of objects.

Can I copy and paste from one SketchUp file to another?

Yes. Select the component and hit Edit>Copy or the appropriate shortcut. Go to the other file and choose Edit>Paste (or appropriate shortcut) or Paste in place.

Can you copy and paste from one SketchUp to another?

You can do this: Open a model, select something you want, do a Copy. Open another model, Paste or Paste in Place.

How do you paste in place in SketchUp?

1. Ctrl + V -> paste in place.
2. Ctrl + Shift + V -> paste.

How do I copy and paste multiple files?

How do you copy and insert rows multiple times?

1. Select a blank row and copy it.
2. Select the rows above which you want to insert the new rows. Select as many rows as you want to insert.
3. Right-click on the mouse and select Insert Copied Cells.

How do I copy and paste fast?

Can you push pull a group in SketchUp?

You have to open the group for editing before you can use Push/Pull on the face inside. Either double click on it with the Select tool or right click on it and choose Edit Group.

What is joint push pull SketchUp?

SketchUp Joint Push/Pull is a plugin or extension for doing push/pull of surfaces in an advanced manner for making them 3D model in SketchUp. With these joint push/pull plugins we can create complex shapes in SketchUp very quickly and easily.

How do you use a push pull?

How do I make a group in SketchUp?

1. With the Select tool (), select all the entities you want to include in your group.
2. Select Edit > Group from the menu bar. Or context-click the selection and choose Group from the menu that appears. Everything in the selection becomes grouped within a bounding box.

How do you select all objects in SketchUp?

How do you select all surfaces in SketchUp?

Turn off edges in the Styles window, then drag over the faces you want to select. You also need to turn off profiles. You can use also a “bucket” with pressing “ctrl” (Windows).

How do you select all components in SketchUp?

Select Instances. Then, right-click and click on “select instances” from the dropdown. The component you are looking for will now be selected and highlighted with a blue bounding box in your model.
