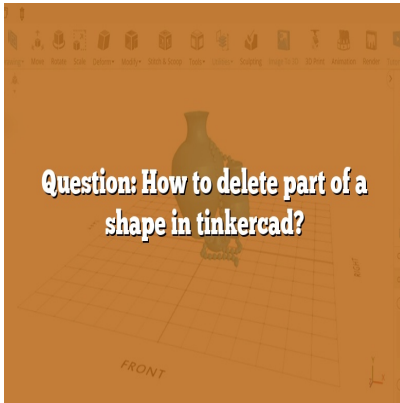

Holes (creating negative space) Any shape you create in Tinkercad can be turned into negative space, or a hole as Tinkercad refers to it. To make a hole, select the object you want to be a hole, then press the Hole option in the Inspector window that appears when you select the object.

The way Tinkercad and most other 3D design websites make cylinders or rounded shapes is by making a series of squares or other shapes to achieve a round look. Adding or removing segments makes the cylinder more rounded or less rounded giving it a smooth and even look or a rough and rigid look.
