1) Start a new, empty drawing in **AutoCAD** 2) Load Cap 3) Attach the DWG created out of Revit as an external reference within AutoCAD a) Typing "XREF" at the **AutoCAD** command line and using the "External Reference" palette is the most common method, but it is also possible via the "Insert" ribbon, in the "Reference" section.

In this regard, how do I import a Revit **file** into DWG?

1. Click Insert tab Import panel (Import CAD).
2. In the dialog, for Files of type, select the desired file type.
3. Navigate to the folder that contains the file to import, and select the **file**.
4. Specify options.
5. Click Open.

Quick Answer, can Revit drawing be converted to AutoCAD? Just in case you need to convert a 3D Revit model to 3D AutoCAD, here ya go. It is very simple but remember to click one button to make sure you work with ACAD solids! With the **Revit** model open, Click the Application Menu (Big R) > Export > CAD Formats > Select DWG.

Furthermore, how do I **open** Revit files in Autodesk?

1. Press CTRL+O .
2. On the Home page, under Models or Families, click Open, or click a thumbnail image in the Recent Files list.
3. Click **File** tab (**Open**).
4. Click File tab (**Open**), and select a file type.
5. Click **File** tab, and select a file from the Recent Documents list.

Also the question is, how do I open an RVT **file** without **Revit**?

1. Use the free online A360 Viewer.
  2. Download the free Design Review 2013 and export the Revit model as a DWF.
  3. Use the **Revit** viewer mode.
  4. If you have Navisworks, you can open the Revit file in Navisworks, then save as an NWD file.
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1. Navigate to the target folder for the exported files.
  2. For Files of type, select an AutoCAD version for the exported DWG/DXF file.
  3. For Naming, select an option for the automatically generated file name.

## What is the Revit project file format?

Revit supports a wide range of industry standards and file formats, including: Revit native formats: RVT, RFA, RTE, RFT. CAD formats: DGN, DWF, DWG, DXF, IFC, SAT, and SKP. Image formats: BMP, PNG, JPG, JPEG, and TIF.

## How do I convert an RVT file to PDF?

1. Click File tab (Print).
2. In the Print dialog, for Name, select your PDF print driver.
3. Click Properties.
4. In the Properties dialog, define settings for the PDF print driver as desired, and click OK.
5. To print only the sheet or view in the drawing area:

## **Is Autodesk Viewer free?**

Autodesk Viewer is a free online viewer that works with over many file types, including DWG.

## **How do I convert Revit to SketchUp?**

1. From the file menu, go to export > options > exports setups dwg/dxf. Click on the solids tab, and select ACIS solids.
2. Hit OK, and return to the export menu > CAD formats > DWG.
3. Import the model into SketchUp Pro.

## **How do I convert 3D view from Revit to 2D in AutoCAD?**

Open the 3D view of the project to export. Click File tab Export CAD Formats (DWG files). In the DWG Export dialog, click (Modify Export Setup). On the Solids tab of the Modify DWG/DXF Export Setup dialog, select Export as AutoCAD Architecture and AutoCAD MEP Objects.

## **What Is DXF File in AutoCAD?**

DXF is short for Drawing Exchange Format or Drawing Interchange Format and is a type of vector file. Many engineers, designers, and architects use the DXF file format for 2D and 3D drawings during product design.

## **How do I export details from Revit?**

1. Select a drafting view in the Project Browser.
2. Right-click the view name, and click Save to New File.
3. Enter a new name for the project. This creates a new Revit project file that contains the selected view and the contents of that view.

## **Is Revit viewer free?**

You can use the Autodesk® Revit® trial, available from the Autodesk website: [www.autodesk.com](http://www.autodesk.com), to view projects for free. After the 30-day trial mode is over, Revit will run indefinitely in Demo Mode.

## How can I open BIM files?

A user can install the Bytessence InstallMaker software into his or her Microsoft Windows-based computer to be able to create and open these BIM files. The content of these BIM files includes details entered by the user to a project developed using the Bytessence InstallMaker program.

## How do I export a Revit 3D model?

1. Click Manage Model.
2. In the Model Explorer panel, make the desired layers visible.
3. Zoom out to see the area to export.
4. Click Present/Share Present.
5. In the Export to 3D Model File dialog box, specify the area to export:

## What is a BIM file?

Building information modeling (BIM) is the process of creating and managing 3D, 4D, and 5D information for a construction project across multiple disciplines. ArcGIS Pro supports BIM design files from Industry Foundation Classes (IFC) formatted files and Autodesk Revit (RVT) as ArcGIS BIM file workspaces.

## How do I open an RVT file online?

1. login to usBIM (click here to access usBIM)
2. create a new folder by clicking the icon at the bottom right of the screen.
3. upload your Revit file into the folder with a simple drag&drop.
4. click on the PC screen icon, next to the file you have just uploaded, and choose the "Open" option.
