ctrl-I will invert the current selection. Also holding ctrl-shift while box selecting will â€˜toggleâ€™™ the selection state of elements that are box picked, which if you box pick all elements will effectively invert the selection.

On the other hand, we can also convert any procedural or generated Cinema 4D object into an editable mesh by selecting it and pressing C on the keyboard. We call it â€˜make editableâ€™. So I can go and select everything else, press C on my keyboard, and now theyâ€™™re all editable objects.

By pressing K you can open the â€˜Knife Toolâ€™™ where you can cut faces, what will create more polygons.

1. To Tumble you could use ALT+Left mouse button.
2. To Zoom ALT+Middle mouse button or click middle mouse button
3. To Pan ALT+Right mouse button.

How do you select a loop in blender?

Select Face Loops In face select mode, holding Alt while selecting an edge selects a loop of faces that are connected in a line end-to-end, along their opposite edges. In vertex select mode, the same can be accomplished by using Ctrl + Alt to select an edge, which selects the face loop implicitly.

Which keyboard shortcut will focus the viewport on the selected object S?

S/H/O = Center Element/Frame All Objects/Fit Selected Object. If you don't want to crane your neck as you work on objects around your viewport, use these keys. S will center any selected element in your viewport so you can work in comfort. O fits the selected object in your viewport.

What is a null in c4d?

A null is basically an object that doesn't render but it has an access. By grouping these objects in this null, we have made them children of the null object. The child objects inherit the values of the parent.
