## Introduction

1. Double-click the SketchUp application icon to launch the application.
2. Click the "Line" tool icon.
3. Click on the starting point for the first line of the grid.

Likewise, how do you view a grid? To show the gridlines, in Excel, PowerPoint, or Word, click the View tab, and then check the Gridlines box. To hide the gridlines, clear the Gridlines check box.

Correspondingly, how do I turn off the grid in SketchUp? Go to Window/Model Info/Units and disable the length snapping and also choose the precision.

## What are grid lines?

Definition of grid line : any of a series of numbered horizontal and perpendicular lines that divide a map into squares to form a grid by means of which any point may be located by a system of rectangular coordinates.

## How do I add a grid in sketch?

To set up a square grid, choose View > Canvas > Show Grid or press "G". To change its settings (the size of the cells, how often thicker lines appear and the color of the lines), choose View > Canvas > Grid Settings or press "G".

## How do you show hidden lines in SketchUp?

Viewing hidden geometry and objects In SketchUp, any geometry that's hidden is still there. You just can't see or select it. To see the hidden geometry or objects but keep them hidden, choose View > Hidden Geometry or View > Hidden Objects.

## Why is my SketchUp showing lines?

Looks like you hit K to turn on back edges. Hit K again to turn them off. By the way, you might consider erasing guides once they've done their job.

## How do I show terrain in SketchUp?

Click the Add Location tool ( ) on the Location toolbar or select File > Geolocation > Add Location. In the Add Location window that appears, type an address or intersection where your desired terrain is located. Click the Search button, and an aerial view of your location appears in the window.

## What does sandbox do in SketchUp?

Terrain is important to many SketchUp modelers: Your building needs ground to stand on, or maybe you're modeling the ground itself to create a landscape. But wait. SketchUp's Sandbox tools – the tools you use to model terrain – can also create forms completely unrelated to terrain.

## How do you add topography in SketchUp?

1. Next create a grouped rectangle that covers the entire site.
2. Move your grouped rectangles (slicing planes), over your terrain again (or unhide).
3. Hide or delete your slicing planes Now you have a topographic map!
4. Sketchup will select all of the faces of your topography map.

## Why are my guides not showing in SketchUp?

Go to the View Menu and see if it has a tick next to it, if not click it to toggle guides on. When view-> guides is off and you use the tape measure tool, you will see a candidate guide as you move the mouse and a guide will actually be created when you click.

## How do you use the grid method?

In a nutshell, the grid method involves drawing a grid over your reference photo, and then drawing a grid of equal ratio on your work surface (paper, canvas, wood panel, etc). Then you draw the image on your canvas, focusing on one square at a time, until the entire image has been transferred.

## How do you put gridlines on a picture?

1. Step 1: Save your reference photo with a new name.
2. Step 2: Crop and resize the reference photo if necessary.
3. Step 3: Adjust your rulers.
4. Step 4: Add a new layer to the photo.
5. Step 5: Begin drawing the grid.
6. Step 6: Number the grid.
7. Step 7: Make a printable drawing grid.

## What is grid template columns?

The grid-template-columns property specifies the number (and the widths) of columns in a grid layout. The values are a space separated list, where each value specifies the size of the respective column.

## How do you set out grid lines?

1. Step 1: Establish a baseline.
2. Step 2: Place pegs along your baseline.
3. Step 3: Place further pegs using right-angled triangles.
4. Step 1: Establish a baseline.
5. Step 2: Place pegs along your baseline.
6. Step 3: Place pegs along perpendicular lines.
7. Step 4: Fill in any missing pegs.

## Where do you put gridlines?

Grid Lines in Plan View They are numbered horizontally and lettered vertically. They can be set up in a rigid grid, say at 4m intervals for example. But we prefer to place them along the outside face of major structural elements, such as the outside face of the foundation, rim joist, stud walls and roof framing.

## How do I turn on Smart Guides in sketch?

Sketch supports many keyboard shortcuts. One such example is for "Smart Guides". By grabbing an object and then pressing ALT (or OPTION), the Smart Guides will show up, highlighting the distance between the selected object and the document edges.

## How do I unhide in SketchUp?

Follow these steps to unhide geometry in SketchUp: To unhide any geometry, first of all, click on the "Edit" option from the menu bar. Then click on the "Unhide" option from there. You will see two options there. The first is "Last" and the second is "All".

## How do I unhide a section plane in SketchUp?

To toggle the visibility of all the section planes in your model, select the Display Section Planes tool ( ). Click this tool again to redisplay the section planes. Alternately, select View > Section Planes from the menu bar.
