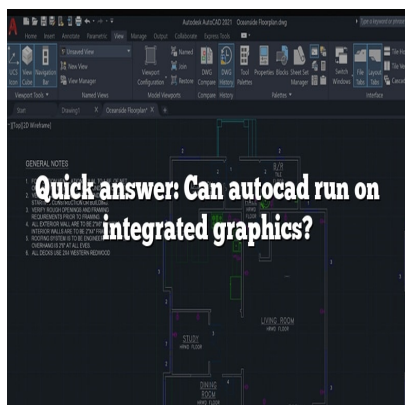

Autocad will "run" on a HD 620 iGPU, however you will have hard time if you're a professional and most of the time you'll find it unusable. The reason is very simple. it's because your iGPU doesn't have its own memory, instead it uses your computer's memory to load 3D textures.

Also know, does AutoCAD work with Intel HD graphics? Intel HD is not a graphic card CAD applications. It might work well for some small drawings, but we have read here a lot of issues with this

onboard GPU, most with performance and driver issues. If CAD is one of your primary jobs, then get a dedicated graphic card. and more RAM.

Amazingly, which graphics card is best for AutoCAD? Therefore, we recommend a low to mid-range NVIDIA Quadro **graphics** card with at least 2GB VRAM for 2D workflows. If you plan on working on 3D models or use another 3D design application such as Autodesk Inventor, we would recommend a 5GB+ NVIDIA Quadro graphics card. CPU. The most important component is the speed, not the count of cores because **AutoCAD** uses mainly one core. For drawings of average size, a speed of 3 GHz and higher is recommended.

Does AutoCAD 2020 require graphics card?

AutoCAD software requires a graphics card to deliver 3D graphics quickly on screen.

Which processor is best for AutoCAD?

NVIDIA driver version 385.41 (or newer) recommended.
