2. In the Scenes manager, select the scene that you want to begin the animation, and select View > Animation > Play from the menu bar.

1. Select the component you want to make dynamic.
2. On the Dynamic Components toolbar, click the Component Attributes tool () or select Window > Component Attributes.

How do you keyframe animations in SketchUp?

Keyframe Animation makes animating objects in SketchUp easy and intuitive. Ordinary scenes act as keyframes. For each scene, just place the objects where you want them to be, and click the Record button. When a scene is selected, the objects will magically translate, rotate, and scale to their recorded values.

Can you take video in SketchUp?

You can record SketchUp animation, then edit, and upload your video on YouTube using Ezvidâ€™s freeware. To animate scenes, you will have to use SketchUpâ€™s animation feature tab. You can export your SketchUp animations to either image sets or video files using the Export tab for both Windows and Mac.

How do you create an animated scene?

How do you make objects move?

1. Then we add â€œMovementâ€• effect. You can do it using toolbar:
2. or using menu â€œAdd object->Movementâ€•. In the open window set start time of effect and its duration and click â€œOkâ€•.
3. When you fulfill these actions you will get the effect of moving object on the scene.

How do you make an animated motion path?

1. Click the object you want to animate.
2. On the Animations tab, click Add Animation.
3. Scroll down to Motion Paths, and pick one. Tip: If you choose the Custom path option, you will draw the path that you want the object to take. To stop drawing a custom path, press Esc.

How do you nudge objects in SketchUp?

The Nudge Tool lets you fine-tune the position of the selected objects using the arrow keys. Just enter a value for the movement increment and the arrow keys will bump the object until you find the perfect placement.

How do you animate a sliding door in SketchUp?

What is a dynamic component?

What dynamic components are. Dynamic means, that the components location in the application is not defined at buildtime. That means, that it is not used in any angular template. Instead, the component is instantiated and placed in the application at runtime.

How do I edit dynamic components in SketchUp?

How do you make a component unique in SketchUp?

Select the component instance that you want to edit. Context-click the selected instance and choose Make Unique, as shown in the figure. If you have the Entity Info panel open, you see that SketchUp changes the Definition by adding #1, or something similar.

How do you walk through animations in SketchUp?

1. Select the Walk tool (). The cursor changes to a pair of shoes.
2. Click and drag the cursor to start walking.
3. Move the cursor up, down, left, or right to move through your model.

How do you do a virtual walkthrough in SketchUp?

How do you make a camera on SketchUp?

1. Select View > Tool Palettes > Advanced Camera Tools (Mac OS X) or View > Toolbars > Advanced Camera Tools (Microsoft Windows).
2. Select Tools > Advanced Camera Tools > Select Camera Type > categories > camera.
3. Click Create Camera ().
4. Type a name of the camera in the Name field.
5. Click Done.

How does keyframe animation work?

Keyframing. Animation is made of numerous frames; when those frames are showed at a certain speed; we perceive the individual frames as moving images. Keyframes are the important frames which contain information of a start/end point of an action.

What is key frame animator?

3D Animation: Keyframing. Keyframing is the simplest form of animating an object. Based on the notion that an object has a beginning state or condition and will be changing over time, in position, form, color, luminosity, or any other property, to some different final form.

How do I create a component in Sketchup?

1. Select the geometry you want to include in your component.
2. Choose Edit > Make Component from the menu bar, or context-click the selection and choose Make Component.
3. In the Definition box, type a meaningful name for your component.
4. In the Description box, add a short description of your component.
