Also, how do you connect lines on Fusion 360?

Also know, how do you merge edges in Fusion 360? Click or hold Ctrl and click to select one or more edges in the first group. In the Merge Edge dialog, select Edge Group Two. Click or hold Ctrl and click to select one or more edges either in the same body or in a second body you want to be joined to the first. Click OK.

Likewise, how do you combine sketches in **Fusion** 360? There are a couple of ways to combine sketches in **Fusion** 360. The first is to copy and paste one sketch into another. Select the first sketch and Copy it to your clipboard. Next, edit your second sketch and select Paste.

You asked, how do you combine shapes in fusion? To join or **combine** solids or bodies, Do the following: Click Design > Solid > Modify > Combine. . From the **Combine** dialog, select the Target Body. With the line command active you can draw a line on any sketch plane or surface of a 3D model. **Lines** can be drawn between any two points at any length or angle needed.

What is a loft in Fusion 360?

A Loft creates a smooth transition between two or more profiles or faces. There are three different loft features in Fusion 360.

What is a loft Fusion?

Learn how to use the Loft command to create a smooth T-Spline body that transitions between two or more sketch profiles or faces in Fusion 360. In the Design workspace, Form contextual environment, select Create > Loft .

How do you combine components?

What is a target body in Fusion 360?

When combining, the target is where the changes will be applied, and the tool is the body that will do the changes. In a cut operation, you remove the overlap between the tool body and the target, from the target body. In a combine operation, you add the tool body to the target.

How do you copy sketches to another plane in Fusion 360?

1. Select wireframe on sketch by dragging a window over sketch items.
2. Then use Ctrl C (Copy).
3. Deselect items.
4. Select a new sketch plane for items to be pasted in.

How do you join two sketches?

How do we use the line command?

1. Open the AutoCAD software.
2. Select the Line icon from the ribbon panel or type L or Line and press Enter on the command line.
3. Specify the starting point and endpoint using the cursor on the workspace or drawing area, as shown in the below image:
4. Press Enter or Esc to exit.

What is the use of line command?

The command line is a text interface for your computer. It's a program that takes in commands, which it passes on to the computer's operating system to run. From the command line, you can

navigate through files and folders on your computer, just as you would with Windows Explorer on Windows or Finder on Mac OS.

Where is the line tool in Fusion 360?

The Line tool in the Sketch > Create panel lets you create a connected series of lines and arcs as sketch geometry or construction geometry in an active sketch in Fusion 360. You can use the following command to create lines in an active sketch: Line.

How do you fillet in Fusion 360?

1. Click Design > Solid > Modify > Fillet .
2. In the dialog, from the Type dropdown list, select Rule Fillet.
3. Select a Rule to create fillets on all edges in a single selection set, or only at shared edges of two selection sets:
4. In the canvas, select faces or features to fillet.

How do you round all edges in Fusion 360?

1. Use window-selection to select all the faces, and then select "All Edges" for Scope option, input the radius you want to do the fillet.
2. In timeline, select all the body features belong to the body, then select "All Edges" for Scope option, input the radius you want to do the fillet.
