Beside above, how do you continue copy in SketchUp? Select the Move tool () from the toolbar or press M. The cursor changes to a four-way arrow. To tell SketchUp that you want to duplicate the selected entities, tap the Ctrl (Microsoft Windows) or Option (macOS) key to toggle Copy functionality. A plus sign appears next to the four-way arrow cursor.

How do you copy an array in SketchUp?

External Array. Open up SketchUp and select the item that you wish to copy. Click on the Move icon and start to move it. After you start to move it, press down on CTRL and move it to where you want the copy.

How do you make a shape follow a path in SketchUp?

1. Identify the path for your extrusion.
2. Draw a face or profile that you want to follow the path.
3. Select the Follow Me tool ().
4. Click and drag the face that you created along the path.
5. Click to complete the Follow Me operation when you reach the end of the path.

How do I use the Follow Me tool in SketchUp?

How do you join lines in SketchUp?

Select the Join tool (), which you find on the default toolbar or by selecting Tools > Join. Click an edge in each piece with the Join tool cursor. A blue outline flashes as you click, and the shape begins to inherit the fill color of the first shape that you click.

How do you repeat an action in SketchUp?

SketchUp does not have a command driven interface. Once a SketchUp tool is activated, it remains active until another tool is selected. This means a user can use the MoveTool successively on as many objects as they wish – no “repeat” necessary.

How do you mirror copy in SketchUp?

To mirror an object with the Scale Tool you will need to select the object first. It can be raw geometry, grouped geometry or components. Next you need to copy that object. The quickest way to duplicate this is to use the CTRL + Move.

How do I array an object in SketchUp?

How do you copy the same object multiple times in SketchUp?

Discussion. To make copies, activate the Move tool and press the Ctrl key (Option on the Mac). SketchUp is very flexible in how you can set the spacing and number of copies: After the first copy is made, you can enter the number of copies you want and set the spacing between them.

How do you copy multiple times?

Copy and paste multiple items using the Office Clipboard Select the first item that you want to copy, and press CTRL+C. Continue copying items from the same or other files until you have collected all of the items that you want. The Office Clipboard can hold up to 24 items.

Can you push pull multiple surfaces in SketchUp?

If we want to extrude (push/pull) a lot of faces the same distance, we might use the default SketchUp Push Pull tool, but it might take very long if we have a lot of faces. By default, if we push one face and then double click on different one, the new one will be push/pulled the same distance.

How do you line up objects in SketchUp?

To align two or more selected elements vertically or horizontally, select Arrange > Align and then select Vertically or Horizontally from the submenu that appears. To center two or more selected elements, select Arrange > Center and then choose Vertically on Page or Horizontally on Page from the submenu.

How do you duplicate objects in SketchUp?

How do you scale and align in SketchUp?

1. With the Select tool (), select the geometry you want to scale.
2. Select the Scale tool () or press the S key.
3. Click an edge or face grip (not a corner grip).
4. Move the cursor to scale the entity.
5. Click to set your selection's new scale.

How do I draw a path in SketchUp?

1. With the Line tool (), click and drag to draw the line.
2. Release the mouse button, and without clicking, move the cursor to set the curve's direction and size, as shown on the left in the following figure.

Where can I find Follow Me SketchUp?

Using the Sketchup Follow Me Tool If you do not have the toolbar, right-click on the top menu and select "Edit". Then from the toolbar, select the follow me tool.

Where is the follow me tool in SketchUp 2020?

With the Select tool (), select the continuous set of edges that represent the path, also shown in the following figure. Select the Follow Me tool ().

Which tool connects a series of segments together in SketchUp?

The Line Tool gives you the power to simply connect a series of line segments together, close loops, create surfaces and edit and refine those surfaces, and it provides the vehicle for nearly every other command, operation or tool to function.
