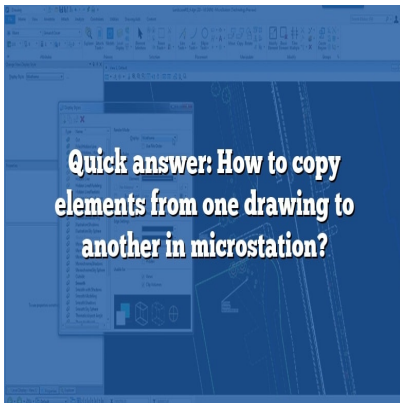

Introduction

1. Select the element(s) you want to copy.
2. Set a tentative snap point on the basepoint about which you’d like to copy.
3. Menu Bar > Edit > Copy.
4. Open the drawing you’d like to copy into.
5. Menu Bar > Edit > Paste.

Correspondingly, how do you copy in MicroStation v8i?

Best answer for this question, how do you forward an element in MicroStation? 07.24 and later, you can change the element order by first creating a selection set of the elements you want to bring to the front and then selecting Edit > Bring to Front. To make it even easier, just put order element front on a function key and away you go!

Also the question is, how do you copy a cell in MicroStation?

1. Do File|Save As and assign the new file a .cel extension.
2. Open that new cell library in MicroStation.
3. Open the Models dialog.
4. For each model that you want to use as a cell, set its Can be Placed as Cell property.
5. Close the cell library.

How do you edit a raster image in MicroStation?

To modify a selected raster image Use the Select Rasters tool, or the Raster Manager dialog box, to select the raster image file to modify. Select the Modify Raster tool. Make the required changes to the settings in the settings window. Identify a handle, or arrow, and drag it to modify the image graphically.

What is a smart line in MicroStation?

Place SmartLine is a tool that produces different type of elements depending on used setting. As Daniel Clark wrote, using Join elements checkbox you can define whether a line will be placed as one line string or as a series of independent lines.

How do you match line styles in MicroStation?

1. Go to the Change Attribute tool.
2. Click on eyedropper(Match Element Attributes)
3. Select the attributes you want to match by checking appropriate boxes.
4. Select new element to apply the attributes from first element.

How do I change order of references in Microstation?

1. Go to File > Reference to open the References dialog box.
2. In the Reference dialog box, go to Settings > Update Sequence to open the Update Sequence dialog box.
3. In the Update Sequence dialog box select the Reference (or active file) and then click the up or down arrow buttons to move the file up or down.

How do I change the order of display levels in Microstation?

Can you explode a cell in MicroStation?

In MicroStation, use the tools in the Drop tool box (Tools > Drop) to break elements into simpler components. The Drop Element tool is for general usage.

How do you move pictures in Microstation?

1. Select the Modify tool.
2. With a data point, identify the image to move. Anchors display on the selected image.
3. Place a data point on the image, away from the image anchor point.
4. Move the image to its new location.
5. Place a data point to complete the move.
6. Reset to deselect the image.

How do I change layers in Microstation?

1. Select all lines (as you have done)
2. Choose the Change Attributes tool.
3. Ensure that the Level checkbox is ticked.
4. Pick the level you want from the option button.
5. Datapoint in your DGN model to accept the change.

How do you scale elements in Microstation?

How do I use the raster manager in MicroStation?

1. Open the Raster Reference Manager.
2. Select your Raster File, i.e. Image.
3. Adjust your Raster Attachment Settings, if needed.
4. Place the Raster in the design file in the position and size needed.

What is raster manager in MicroStation?

Raster Manager is the name of the principal module in MicroStation that is responsible for opening and visualizing raster imagery in MicroStation. Using Raster Manager you can open and display images of various formats, from monochrome to full color.
